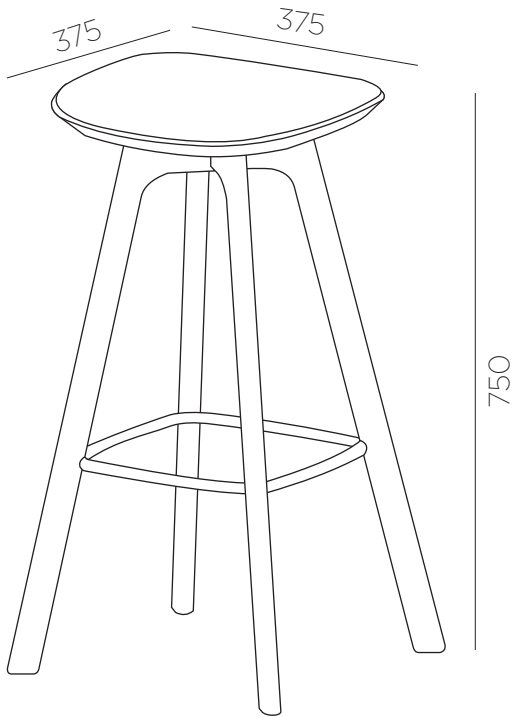

Test and Certification

This stool has been tested for strength, durability, and safety through independent third-party verification in accordance with EN 16139 Level 2, making it suitable for extreme use. The wood is sourced from sustainably managed forests and certified by PEFC through independent third-party verification.

The Clear Oil features a low VOC content and is fully compliant with EU regulations. This product contains no biocides, ensuring a natural and environmentally responsible finish. Worker safety is a high priority, with all processes conducted under controlled conditions in accordance with unions and national regulations.

Variants

Available in two wood finishes - Oiled Oak and Fumed Oiled Oak. The seat can be selected with different upholstery choices spanning premium leathers and fabrics. The base is offered in either matching wood or matte black powder-coated steel.

Materials, Process and Finishing

Crafted from solid European oak combines modern CNC milling with traditional hand-finishing techniques. Each of its precision-made components is assembled with meticulous attention to detail, ensuring durability and a timeless aesthetic. Surfaces are finely sanded by hand for a smooth, tactile finish, and a clear oil is applied to protect the wood while preserving its natural character and repairability. The wide color choice of upholstery materials was designed to harmonize with the natural wood tones.

Fumed Oak Process

For a deeper tone, the oak undergoes a traditional fuming process, where it is exposed to a small amount of ammonia vapors in a sealed environment for 20 hours. This reaction with the wood's natural tannins enhances the grain structure and deepens the color. As a natural, non-surface-based treatment, no dyes are used, preserving the wood's authentic character. Variations in hue may occur depending on the tannin content of each piece.

Craftsmanship Statement

We support and foster the Danish cultural heritage of craftsmanship by preserving and advancing the traditional techniques nurtured in our family workshop since 1886. This commitment reflects both the preservation of the craft and its evolution through the integration of new techniques, innovation, and design development.

The Pauline Bar Stool is a refined embodiment of commitment to quality and offers a harmonious blend of form and function that transcends trends and endures over time. Its slender silhouette and understated elegance reflect Danish craftsmanship. It is suitable for various settings, from residential kitchens to hospitality environments and restaurants.
