Material

Plywood frame, HR foam, polyester wadding, steel, polished or power-coated aluminium.

This product has not been treated with any biocides.

Production process

The plywood frame is upholstered with foam and a textile cover. The upholstered cushions are made from HR foam with duvets filled with silicone fibers and attached to the frame with velcro. The armrests are made of a steel construction which is wrapped in hard foam and attached to the frame using a bolt connection. The legs are made of cast aluminium which is either polished or powder-coated.

Recycling

All fabric, foam, wooden and metal parts can be separated and delivered to a suitable recycling station.

Spare parts

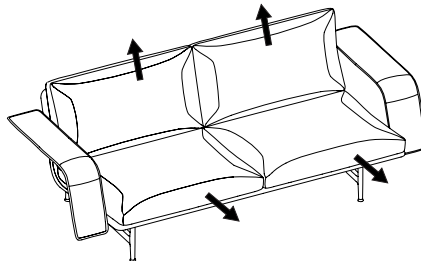

5 year warranty

Safety Precautions

- Do not disassemble alone
- Be aware of the the risk of crushing fingers or other body parts
- The screws might be oiled, so be aware not to get any oil on to the upholstery

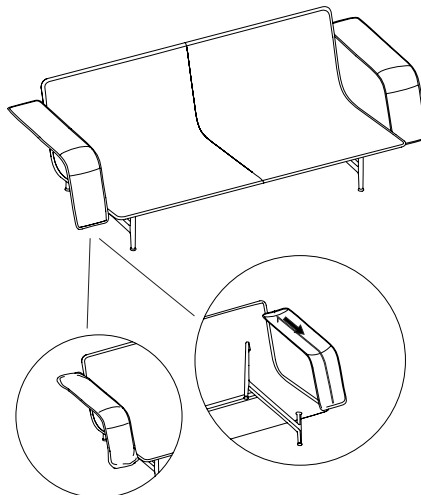

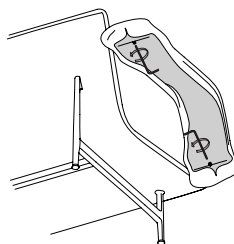
1. Remove seat and back cushions from the sofa before starting the disassembly.

2. Identify the zipper located on the bottom side of the armrests and carefully unzip it to open the fabric. Gently pull the fabric sideways, partially removing it to expose the internal structure of the armrests.

NB: Don't try to remove the fabric completely before completing step 3 and 4.

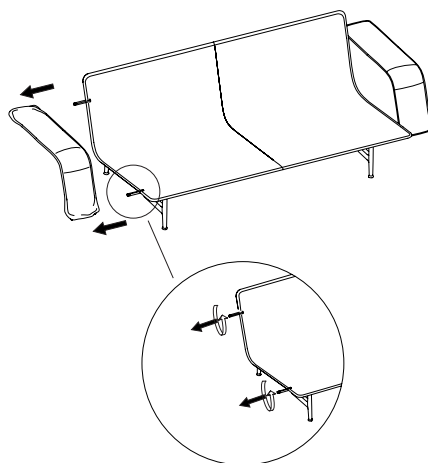


3. Insert the Allen key into the top screw on the bottom side of the armrest and turn counterclockwise to remove it. Repeat the process for the bottom screw.

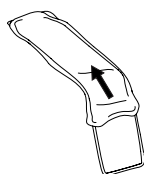

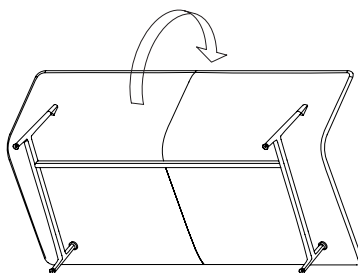

4. Grasp each armrest firmly and gently pull it away from the main frame. If there is any resistance, check for the screws (Step 3) that need to be removed.

5. Using your hands, grasp each metal shaft firmly and turn counterclockwise to unscrew it from the frame. No additional tools should be necessary for this step.



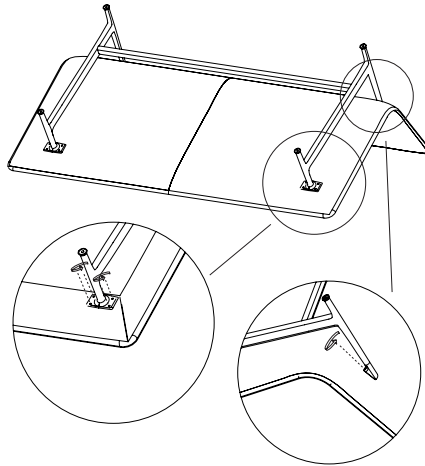
6. With the armrests already detached, carefully finish removing the fabric from the armrest. Once fully separated, set the fabric aside for recycling or disposal.



7. To continue the disassembly, flip the sofa upside down. You need assistance of an additional person to safely perform this action.

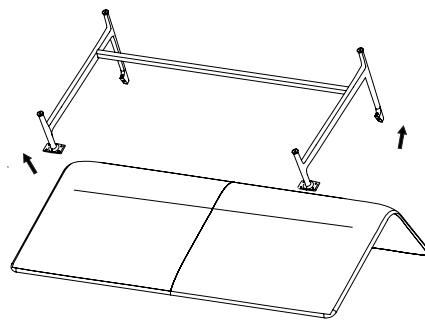

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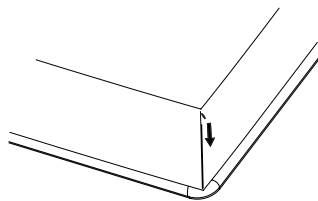

8. Unscrew the 4 screws from each front leg completely, and loosen the screws attached to the backrest.



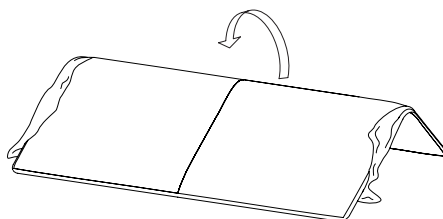
9. Separate the metal base from the frame.



10. Identify the zippers positioned at the backside corners of the seating area. Gently pull the zipper tab to loosen the cover. Repeat this step for the other corner.

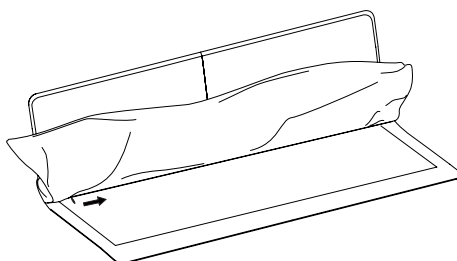

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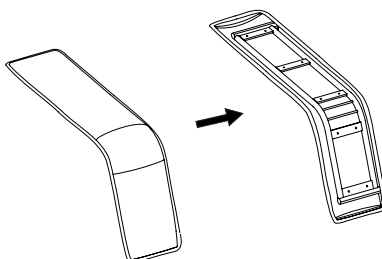

11. Proceed with the removal of the textile cover from the seating area. Please be aware that you may need to flip the frame once more to proceed.



12. Locate and unzip the zipper in the seat bend to completely release the cover from the frame.

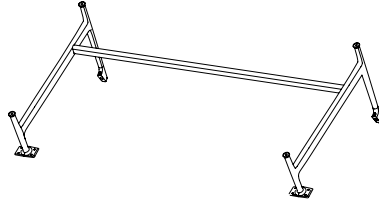
NB: To clean the cover, you need to stop at this step. After cleaning, follow the steps in reverse order to reassemble the sofa. If you wish to fully disassemble the sofa into its components, please continue with the following steps.



13. Carefully peel away the foam from the metal frame. You may need to gently pry it off or use a tool like a putty knife to separate stubborn areas. Dispose both the foam and the metal frame in accordance with local recycling or waste disposal guidelines.

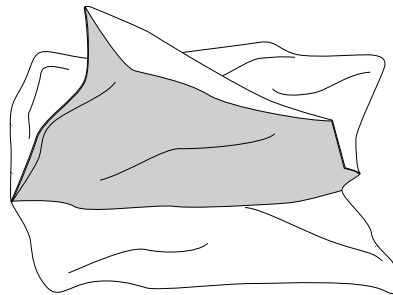
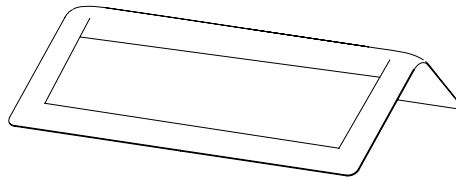

14. Finally, separate the frame into its metal, foam, and wooden components. Dispose the materials in accordance with local recycling or waste disposal guidelines.



15. Remove the wadding from the textile by carefully cutting it with a knife or pulling it off by hand.
