5 YEAR WARRANTY

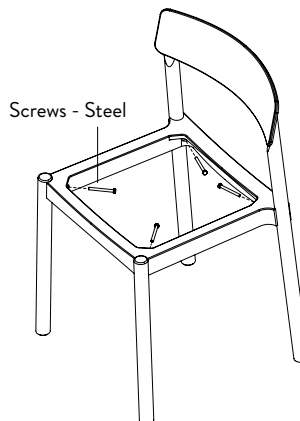

DISASSEMBLY

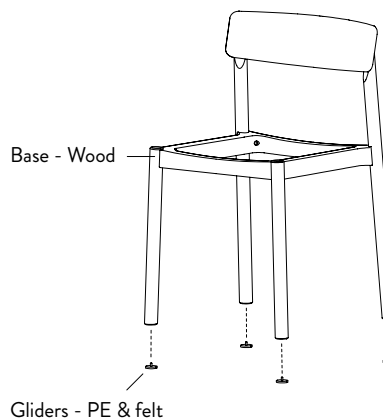
1. To disassemble the Betty chair first remove the webbing from the seat.



2. Unscrew the bolts located inside the frame of the seat. This can be done with a socket wrench.



Remove the gliders.
