Color Description

Silver Travertine is a natural colour defined by layered tones of silver-grey, taupe, and soft earthy undertones. The interplay of these shades creates depth, warmth, and a sense of quiet strength. Timeless and versatile, this colour bridges ancient character with contemporary elegance, offering a grounded yet refined presence in any setting.

Maintenance Guide Description

This piece combines the natural elegance of Silver Travertine with the sculptural strength of hand-painted fiber concrete. Both materials are crafted to endure, yet each requires mindful care to preserve its beauty.

For Silver Travertine, dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth. Because travertine is naturally porous, wipe spills immediately to prevent staining from liquids such as wine, coffee, or oils. Avoid acidic or abrasive cleaners, as these can etch or dull the surface. For lasting protection, professional sealing is recommended.

For hand-painted fiber concrete, clean only with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use water, soap, or chemical cleaners, as moisture and detergents may damage the painted finish. Avoid abrasive pads or rough materials. Protect surfaces with coasters, mats, or felt pads to prevent scratches, stains, or heat marks, and handle objects carefully to avoid impact on edges or corners.

With consistent, thoughtful care, the natural character of travertine and the refined finish of hand-painted fiber concrete will retain their contrast and harmony, allowing the furniture to age gracefully while maintaining its sculptural presence.

Materials Description

This material pairing unites the natural character of Silver Travertine with the sculptural strength of fiber concrete. Silver Travertine, known for its soft greys, layered striations, and subtle tonal shifts, brings a sense of grounded elegance shaped by millennia of sedimentary formation. Each piece is distinct, with linear patterns that add texture, depth, and a calm visual rhythm.

In contrast, fiber concrete offers stability and resilience. Reinforced with fibers and cast in molds, it allows for bold sculptural forms while remaining lightweight and durable. When combined, the refined natural beauty of travertine and the architectural strength of concrete create a dialogue between organic texture and precise craftsmanship.

The result is a material composition that is both expressive and enduring; timeless stone anchored by crafted concrete, designed to enrich furniture with contrast, balance, and sculptural presence.
