A strong and distinctive sign characterises the Brick family of tables. Nordic references are evident in the base made of sections of natural debarked hornbeam trunk, which is in visual contrast to the thin waxed iron sheet top.

The table tops are in hot-rolled steel plates, thickness 4 mm. They can present different colour shades, scratches, specks, rust spots and some small imperfection as they are totally “handmade” . To protect their surface and avoid the small rust spots spreading out (typical to steel), the last working phase involves a special pickling process and a wax treatment, to be repeated regularly. Avoid contact with water and other liquids.

The wood is barked on its natural shape, that means:

- shape: the perimeter can change from “nearly round/oval” to a “petal shape” ;
- finish: the bases are completely natural, it means that they are just barked. Their finish can change from “cleaned/bleached” to “dark spots finish” .

Even if the material is previously dried, the trunks can have some visible cracks already by buying them or later on after using them. Being the stools a completely natural product characterised by all the above mentioned features, the images of the catalogue suggest an indication only. We cannot grant that the final products will be

exactly the same as represented in the catalogue. Despite a process of aging, the trunks keep a natural and important percentage of residual humidity; this humidity decreases with the passage of time. If the articles are placed on a carpet or on a parquet floor we recommend to assemble the provided nylon glider to the bottom of the article in order to allow its aeration. To have a major protection we recommend to interject between the trunk and the pavement a felt pad (at least of 10 mm).

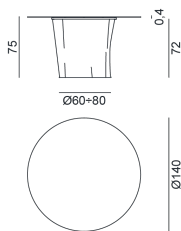

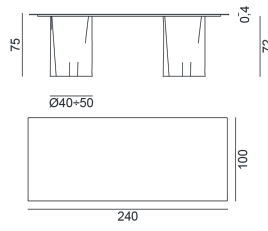


Hornbeam trunk

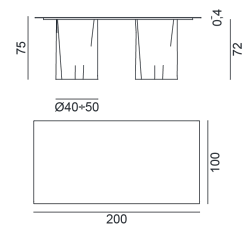

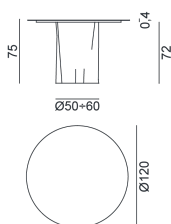
