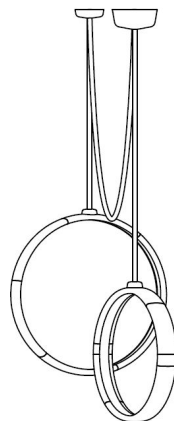
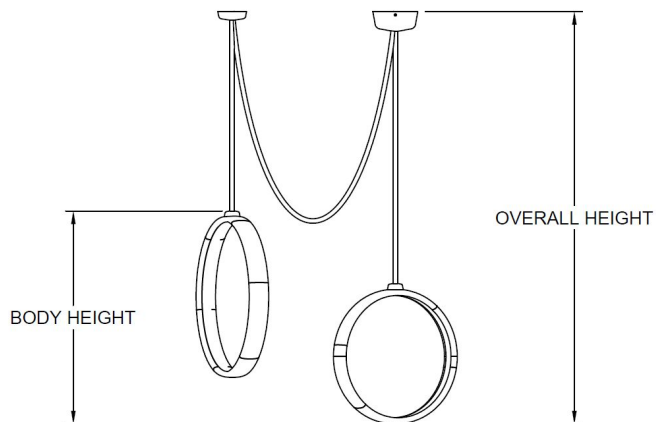
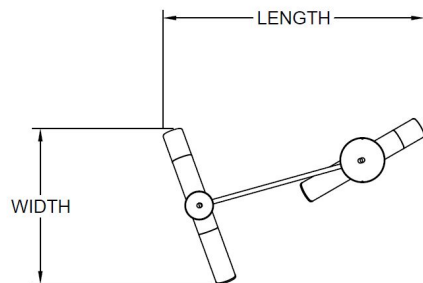
Swag Pendants - Two Rings

Exceptional craftsmanship. Unlike anything else.

White porcelain rings hang from sweeping braided metal cords. Warm, dimmable LEDs are inlaid on the inside surface of each ring.

The sculpture is inspired by a solar eclipse, one of nature's most powerful aesthetic displays. The free form of the sweeping cords contrasts with geometric perfection of the porcelain rings. These two styles come together in an unexpected harmony and visual magnetism.

The sculpture can cast gentle candlelight on a dining table or brighten an entire room.

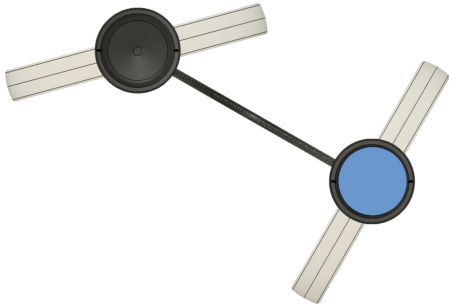

Fixture is OFF-CENTER with respect to the ceiling electrical box.



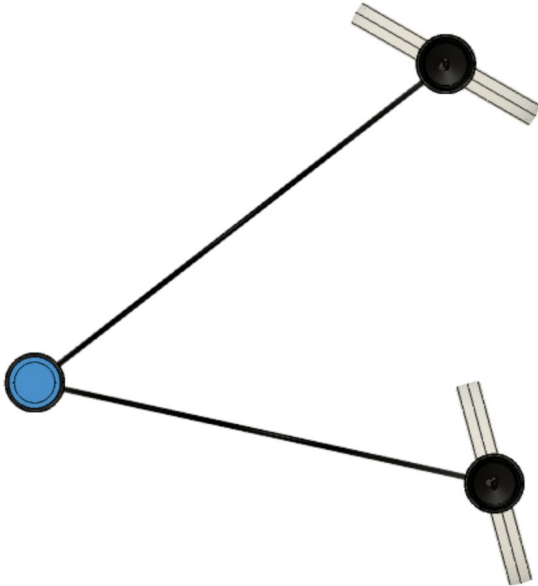

Fixture is OFF-CENTER with respect to the ceiling electrical box.



Junction Box Location & Swag Cords

When selecting a configuration, consider the location of the ceiling electrical connection shown in blue in the mockups to the right.

Adding a Swag Cord

A swag cord can be added to any design. This is useful if you want to hang the pendant in a location other than where the ceiling electrical connection is.

Removing a Swag Cord

A swag cord can be removed from any design. This can be achieved by having your electrician run a low voltage wire (shown in red) through the ceiling cavity from the primary electrical connection to one of the pendant canopies.
