

Trail work at Sunol Wilderness Regional Preserve

May 16 - 18, 2025

We're headed to the beautiful Sunol Wilderness Regional Preserve to work on improving the Eagle View Trail. The project will include widening the tread, enhancing an existing switchback, and replacing several substandard retaining structures.

To make this a true wilderness experience, we'll be camping at the High Valley Group Camp, located just over a mile uphill from the parking lot. While most volunteers will need to hike from the parking area to the campsite, a gear shuttle will be available with limited space for a few volunteers who require a ride.
