TREASURER'S REPORT: Gena Mikkelsen	 See report and note the following: Endowment is in the red because of the declining market conditions. We finished the FY with a surplus of \$167K Will be preparing our 990 with M Tausen for the next FY soon. We have \$559,354 not currently invested. The Finance Committee recommends the following two motions: Motion #1 Close First Federal with \$66,641.41 and Morgan Stanley with \$8,918.88. Transfer this amount, \$75,560.29, to Peoples Bank. 		

	ACTION: Barbara Ryan moved, and Charli Daniels seconded Motion #1, and the board approved the motion unanimously. Motion #2 Move \$35,000 to WECU and \$35,000 to Peoples Bank with a 1% CD Rate for 24 months. We want to keep money liquid with a projected negative budget, leaving \$489,355 available. ACTION: Gena Mikkelson moved, and Corey Welch seconded Motion #2, and the board approved the motion unanimously.
