Thank you to our volunteers, The King's School Rugby Club, who will be running the canteen and barbecues throughout the event. In addition, several coffee carts will be available on site.

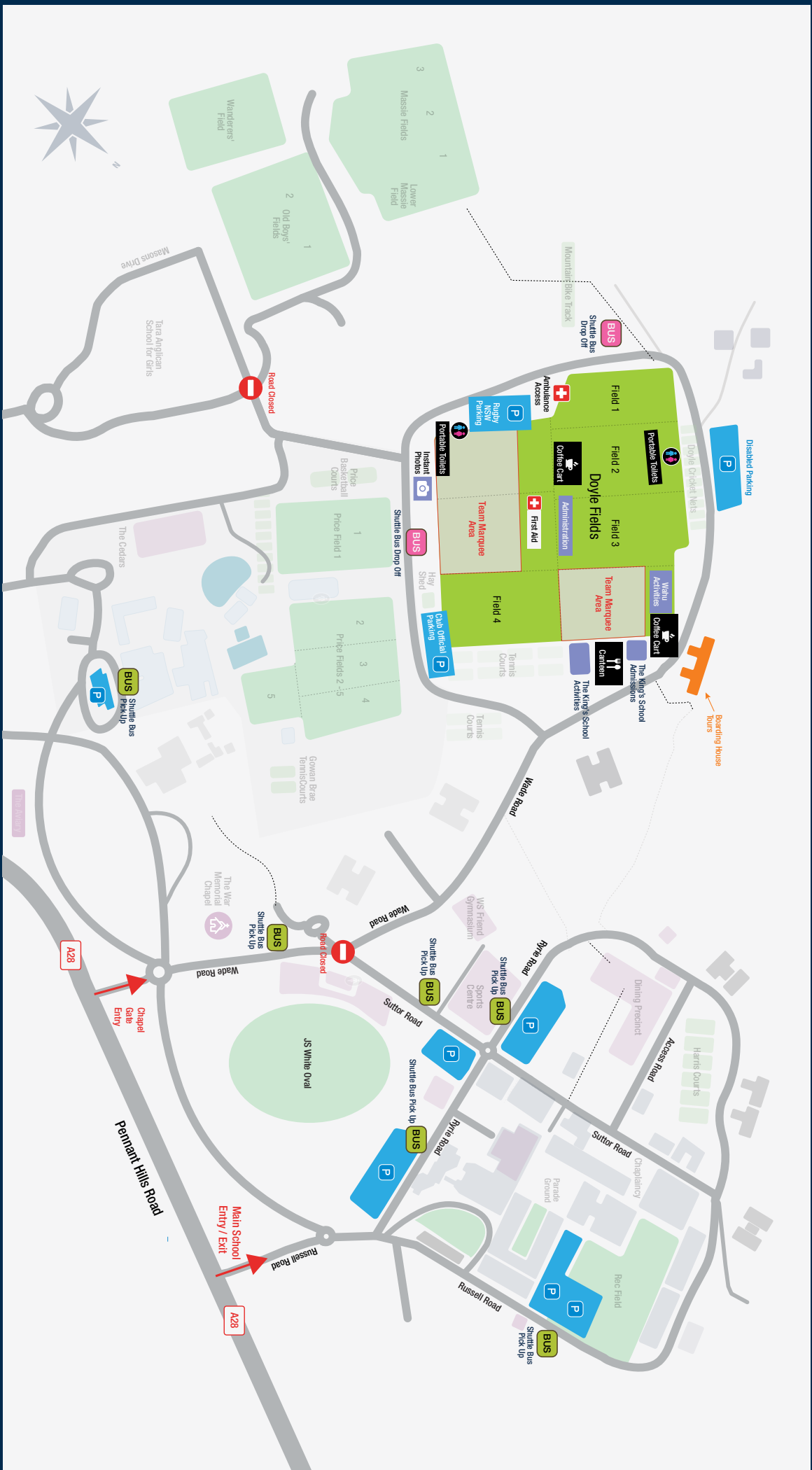
A special thank you to Rugby NSW for the opportunity to host this important grassroots event.

KEY INFORMATION

PARKING

On-site parking is available for all visitors. Please refer to the site map for clearly marked parking zones.

The campus can be accessed via two main entrances on Pennant Hills Road. Upon arrival, please follow the directional signage and the guidance of our traffic management team, who will assist you in locating available parking and the playing fields.

A limited number of parking spaces will be reserved near the fields for club officials, along with designated accessible parking bays for vehicles displaying a valid permit.

Given the size of The King's School's 364-acre campus, complimentary shuttle services will operate between designated parking areas and the playing fields. These will run continuously from 7.30am to 5.00pm daily.

To ensure a smooth arrival, we recommend allowing extra time for parking and travel within the campus.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

The King's School community operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Although the Gala is hosted during term break, students, staff and families will be living and moving around the campus throughout the weekend. Please exercise care and consideration for our residents, students and staff to ensure School life continues safely and without unnecessary disruption.

Please drive carefully, observe all speed limits on School grounds, and follow the instructions of traffic management staff at all times.

Emergency vehicle access routes must remain clear and unobstructed. Please park only in designated areas and comply with signage and directions.

Please dispose of all rubbish in the bins provided to help keep our grounds clean and safe.

No BBQs, open flames or similar cooking equipment may be brought on site.

There is strictly no alcohol to be brought onto the campus and the campus is completely smoke-free.

Visitors enter the campus at their own risk and must comply with all directions from The King's School staff, volunteers and event officials.

The King's School accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any personal property while on campus.

As a residential school with many families on site, we are proud to be a pet-friendly campus. If you choose to bring your pet, please ensure it is kept on a lead at all times and that you clean up after it. Owners remain fully responsible for the behaviour and control of their animals.

The King's School reserves the right to delay, relocate or cancel games if ground conditions become unsafe or risk significant damage to the playing fields. Any changes will be communicated to team managers and posted on the NSWJRU and School websites as soon as possible.

HOURS OF ACCESS

Shuttle Services from the allocated parking areas will run from 7.30am - 5.00pm on Saturday and Sunday.

TEAM AREAS

There are two areas located on the site map for teams to place a marquee. Please do not set up a marquee outside of these areas. No tent pegs are to be used for marquees or shelters, due to underground irrigation pipes. Please use water weights or approved alternatives only.

Teams may warm up in the open grass areas adjacent to the playing fields but must ensure they do not interfere with matches in progress.

ADMINISTRATION LOCATION

The Rugby NSW Administration Team are located between the team area and Rugby fields 1, 2 and 3. Please refer to the site map for their location.

TOILET AND CHANGE ROOM FACILITIES

There is a toilet block located at the canteen. There will be additional portable toilets located behind fields 2 and 3 and next to the Team Area. Please refer to the site map for locations.

There are no change room or laundry facilities available on site.

CANTEEN AND BBQS

The canteen and BBQs will be operating from 7.30am - 3.00pm on Saturday and Sunday. There will also be two coffee carts located around the playing fields.
