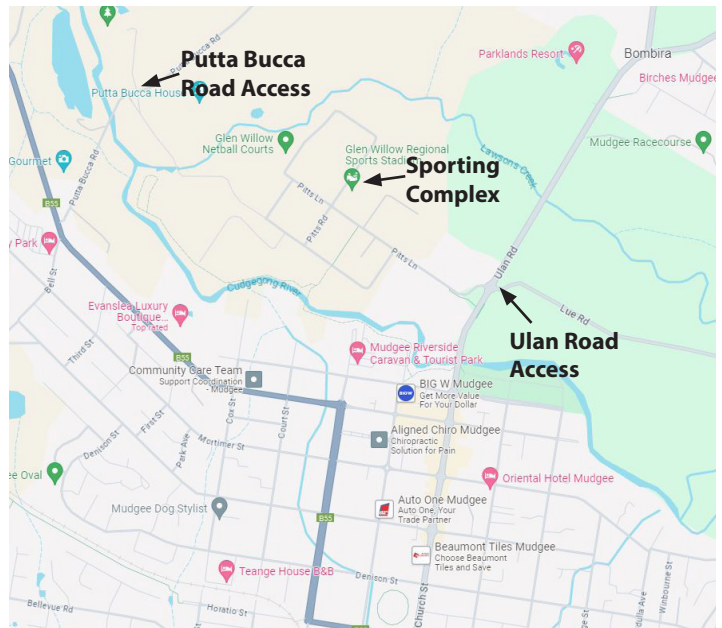
Venue Hours of Access

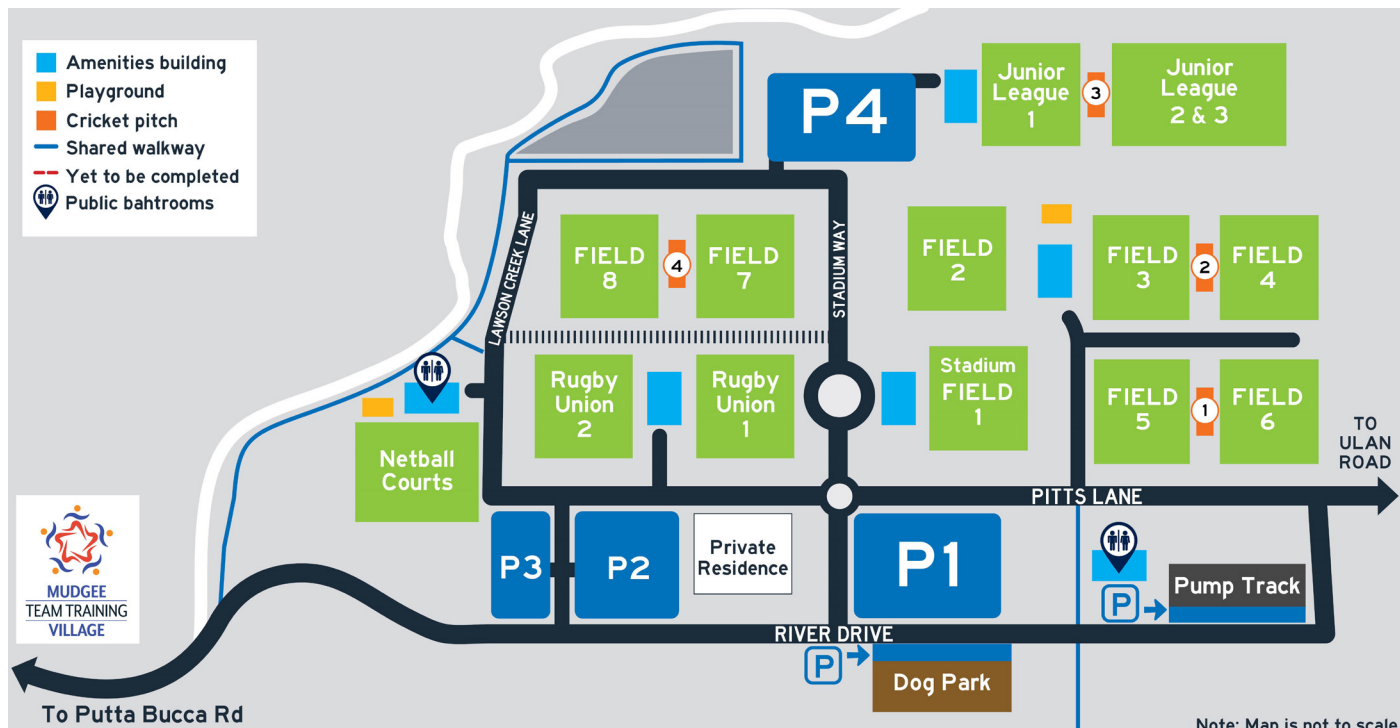

Code of Conduct

The championships will be conducted in accordance to Rugby Australia and NSWJRU Code of Conduct. Any breach, will be taken seriously. Individuals and teams can, and will be ejected from the competition. Zero policy of abuse, any abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.

Sign on area for teams

Will be located under the grandstand of the main field.

Team Dressing Rooms

Please ensure that you leave the dressing rooms clean and tidy for the next team. Do not leave any equipment of gear in the dressing rooms as their security cannot be guaranteed and the space is to be vacated for the next team to utilize.

Marquees

Marquees are welcome, a can be placed in areas marked on the map below.

Police

NSW police have been notified of the competition. Any criminal or illegal behavior will be reported to the police.

Prohibited Items

Please be aware of the below prohibited items within the Glen Willow Sporting Complex:

- BBQ, cooking facilities or implements of any kind
- Glassware
- Animals – other than assistance

Alcohol

The venue is a licensed area, no alcohol is to be bought into the grounds

Ground Marshall

A Ground Marshall will be designated to each ground. The Ground Marshalls will be supplied by Mudgee Rugby Club. The Ground Marshall will ensure that:

- All teams are in the designated technical zones.
- Coaches and Managers are within the designated technical zones.
- Behaviour of players and officials is at a standard that is expected.
- No abuse or heckling of the referee or linespersons will be tolerated by the Ground Marshalls. Such behaviour may lead to ejection from the ground.
- Ensure smooth and timely running of all games.
- Report incidents of crowd behaviour.
- Ensure that spectators also follow the rules of conduct set out by the ARU and Country Rugby.

Rubbish

Garbage bins will be provided for each ground. Please ensure your teams clean up their areas prior to leaving.

Canteen Facilities

Full canteen and barbeque facilities will be available over the three days. The canteen will be located by the Clubhouse between fields Rugby 1 and Rugby 2
