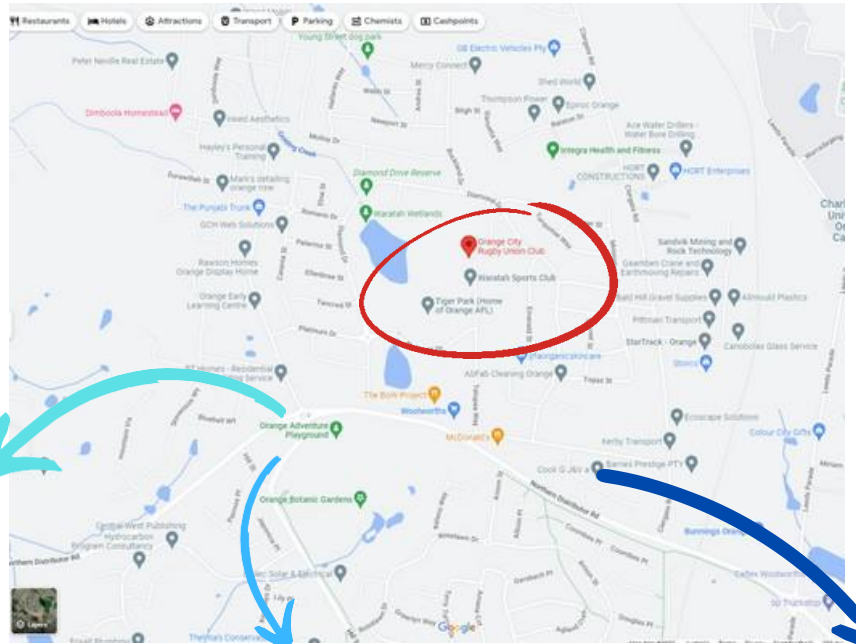

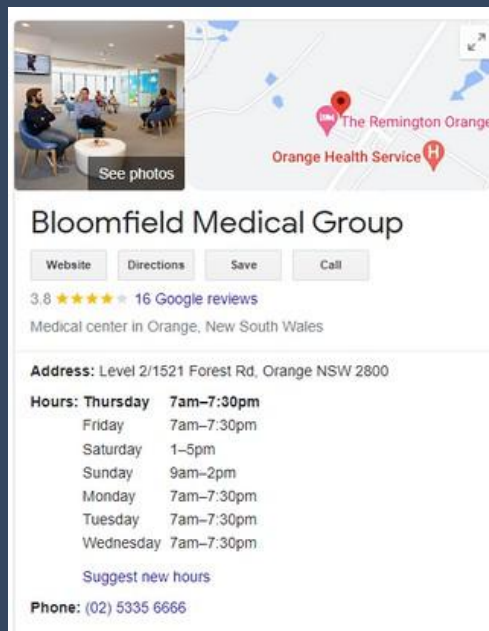
FIRST AID AND MEDICAL

CODE OF CONDUCT

The competition will be run in accordance to the Rugby AU rules and policies

- Ground marshals will be around the grounds, please follow their instructions
- Respect all officials and referees, abuse of any sort will not be tolerated.
- When speaking to kids: Keep it positive. Keep it fun.

SHOOSH FOR KIDS

- Supporting the coaches: Let coaches do the coaching.
- Volunteer appreciation: Remember, volunteers run kids sport.
- Respecting the officials: Respect the referee

PROBITED ITEMS

- Alcohol – this is a Junior Rugby Tournament and no alcohol is permitted at the venue. The Wartah Sports Club is immediately adjacent to the Playing Field and drinks can be purchased and consumed in the licence facility only.
- Glass, glassware, glass bottles of any kind, this is for player safety
- No BBQ cooking facilities (gas or wood). Orange City Rugby will provide a BBQ and Spit Roast and we encourage supporting the club by purchasing from our canteens.
- No fire pits. Orange City Rugby will provide fire bins.
