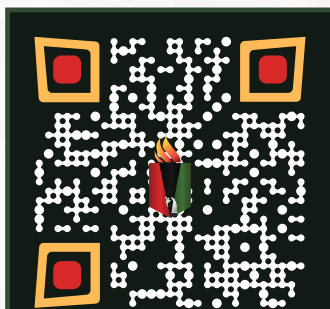

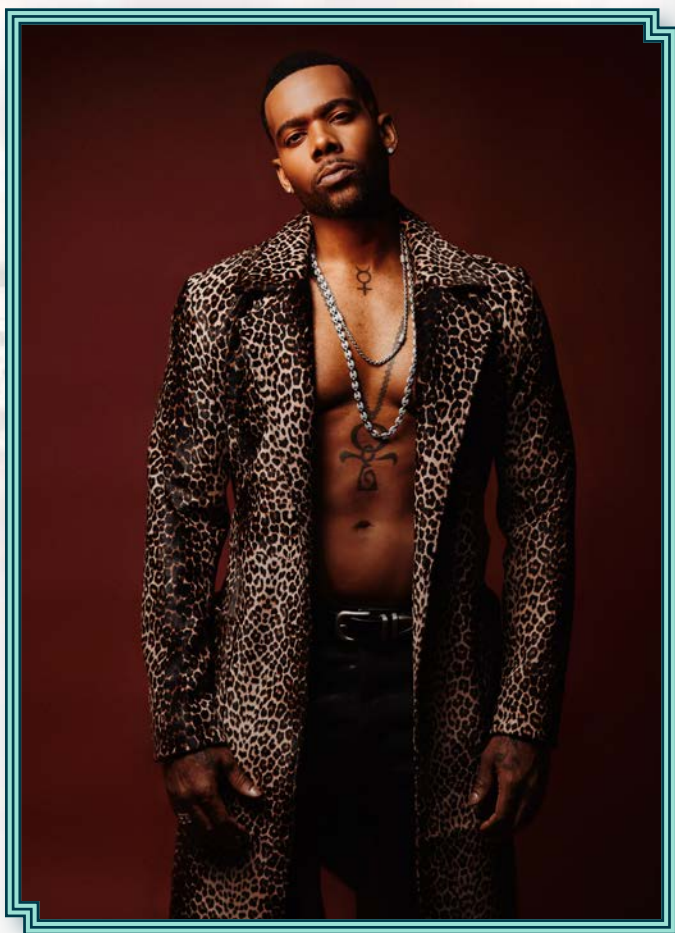

Mario Official Headliner

Mario is a GRAMMY-nominated, platinum-selling R&B singer, songwriter and hitmaker hailing from Baltimore, MD. A dominant 2000s run, which began after the church-bred singer was signed by Clive Davis to J Records during his teenage years, included Top 5 hit "Just A Friend," and "Let Me Love You," the generation-defining serenade that spent nine weeks at no. 1 on the Billboard Hot 100, earning the singer widespread acclaim. Mario's subsequent album, *Turning Point*, generated a 'Best Contemporary R&B Album' GRAMMY nomination as well as two Billboard Awards, and is part of a robust catalog that includes four debuts inside the Top 5 of Billboard R&B/Hip Hop Albums chart, beginning with his gold-certified debut, *Mario*

Mario's hit-making prowess and status as a superior vocal performer led to a spot on Billboard's 'Artist of the Decade' list. His expanded entertainment profile includes an independent label, New Citizen, launched in 2016, and a slew of marquee acting appearances, including major roles in blockbuster films and shows *Step Up*, *Freedom Writers*, and *Empire*. Mario will make his film production debut this holiday season, when his New Citizen-produced Christmas film, *Style Me For Christmas*, airs on BET.

This December, Mario is releasing his sixth studio album as part of his new deal with Epic Records, marking his first solo LP since 2018. *Glad You Came*, is executive-produced largely by James Fauntleroy, who worked for over a year on the project in-studio with Mario. "James and I have a similar philosophy when it comes to the love of timeless music. The omnipresence of all of the things that lends itself to the writing process. Our stories, our lives, what we observe and absorb."

Tierra Kennedy Official Headliner

Born and raised in Gardendale, Alabama, 27-year-old R&B / country / Gospel trailblazer Tiera Kennedy is in bloom. Inspired by artists like Aaliyah and Loretta Lynn, Tiera released her full-length debut album **ROOTED** on October 18, 2024. Fully embracing newfound independence, reaping the harvest of what she's sown over the past 8+ years of making music, cultivating and growing a sonic lane all her own – **ROOTED** takes a moment to smell the roses across 11 unfiltered, self-penned songs.

A singer-songwriter, musician, radio host, entrepreneur, and philanthropist, the multi-hyphenate found another watershed moment last year when lifelong hero Beyoncé asked her to be a featured vocalist on 2025 GRAMMY **Album of the Year** and **Country Album of the Year** winner, **Cowboy Carter**, singing on "BLACKBIIRD" and providing background vocals on "TYRANT."

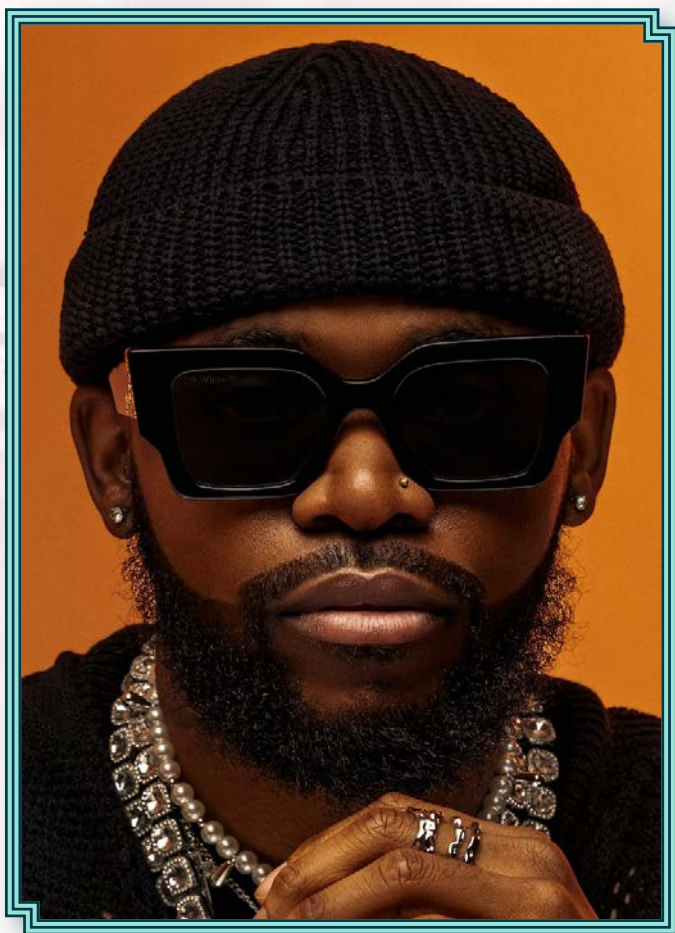
Invested in by generations of cross-genre talent before her, Tiera has also been mentored by pop country icon Shania Twain since the inception of her career, and collaborated with Dolly Parton and Dionne Warwick on the music video for their duet, "Peace Like A River." She's opened for Kelsea Ballerini, Nelly, and more, and serves as direct support for GRAMMY-nominated duo The War & Treaty this spring. "I'm stepping into an era publicly - both musically and personally - that is entirely me," she shares. "It's been inspiring to find myself; in what I thought was my lowest low, I could finally see the roots of what had been growing all along."

Kim Burrell Gospel Performer

Kim Burrell, an award-winning singer, songwriter, and vocal arranger, is celebrated as one of the most influential voices of her generation. Her three-decade plus career showcases a signature blend of gospel, jazz, R&B, and soul, marked by exceptional vocal agility and a rich tone. Born in Houston, Texas, Burrell honed her craft in church, drawing inspiration from icons like Ella Fitzgerald and The Clark Sisters. Her groundbreaking 1998 album, *Everlasting Life*, established her as a force in contemporary gospel, introducing her unique sound to a wider audience.

Burrell's extraordinary talent has led to collaborations with renowned artists across genres, including Whitney Houston, Stevie Wonder, and Pharrell Williams. Her work with Houston on "I Look to You" and her collaboration with Williams on "I See a Victory" (featured in *Hidden Figures*) highlight her versatility. Beyond performance, Burrell is a sought-after vocal coach and mentor, shaping the artistry of numerous contemporary singers. Her influence on vocal technique, particularly in improvisation, phrasing, and jazz-gospel fusion, has earned her reverence among musicians.

An ordained pastor and speaker, Burrell can connect through both song and message which shines light on her multifaceted influence. Kim Burrell's legacy is one of innovation, excellence, and artistic integrity, solidifying her status as an enduring and transformative figure in music.

Marcus has been acknowledged by Lifestyles Magazine as one of "Nashville's 25 Most Beautiful People" (flattered and amused) and number fourteen among "The 50 Hottest Anchors in the World" (according to Buzzfeed.com in 2017). Marcus is graduate of the University of Memphis, and a member of The National Association of Black Journalists, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated, and the Church of Christ.

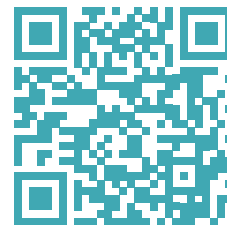
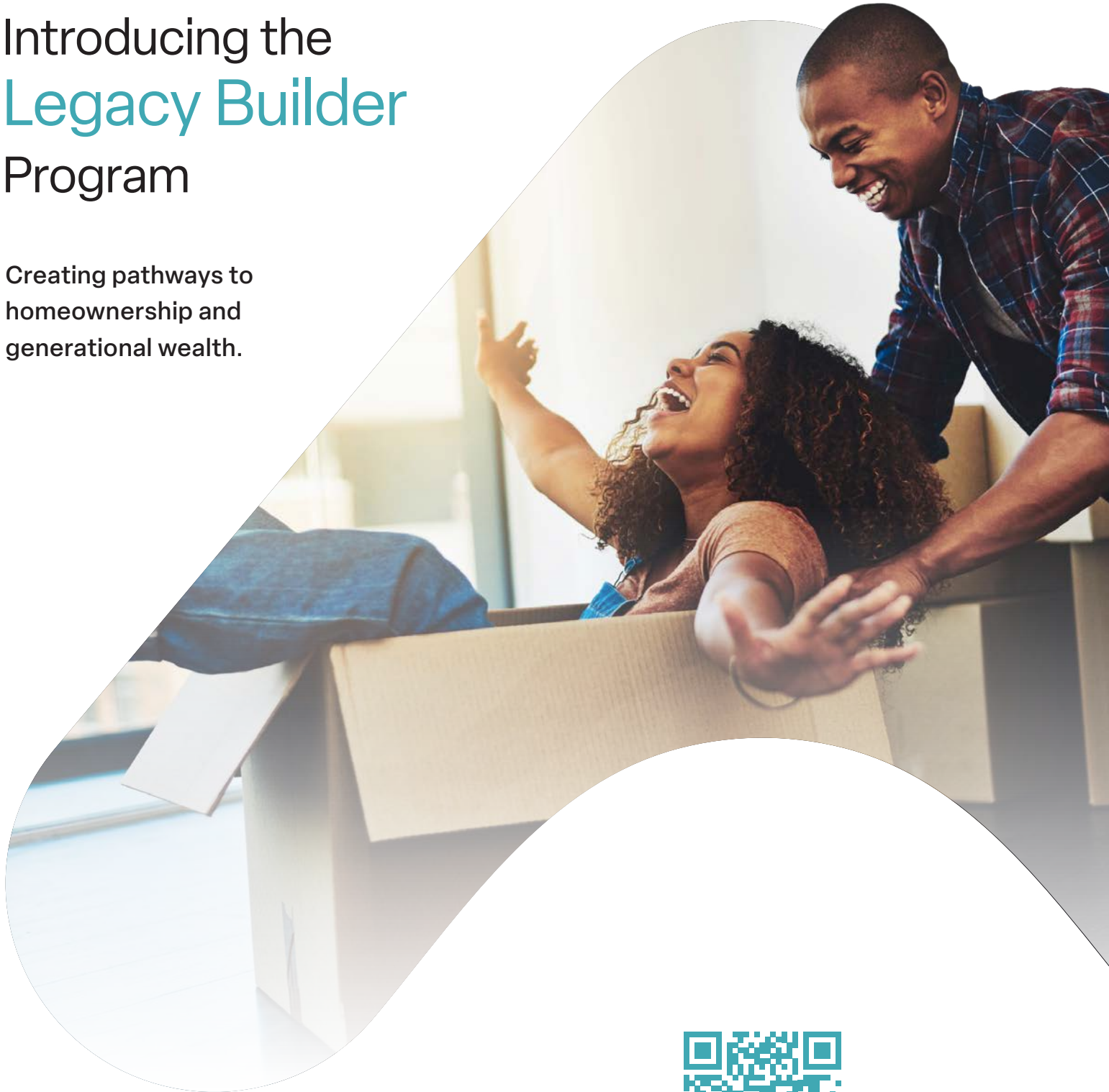
