CONSECRATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO OUR LORD'S SACRED

HEART BALTIMORE (<u>LifeSiteNews</u>) — The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) voted overwhelmingly Tuesday in favor of a measure to consecrate the nation to Our Lord's Sacred Heart next June to commemorate the 250th anniversary of its founding. This will notably be the first time the United States has been consecrated to Our Lord's Sacred Heart. Before the consecration, as part of the initiative, dioceses across the country will be encouraged to invite the faithful to participate in various acts of devotion, such as offering 250 works of mercy or dedicating 250 hours to Eucharistic adoration leading up to the consecration. Prayer resources, including a novena leading up to the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, will also be developed by the USCCB. Indeed, there are an abundance of graces the faithful can gain by consecrating themselves or their households to Our Lord's Sacred Heart. In fact, Our Lord gave St. Margaret Mary Alacoque 12 special

promises for the faithful who consecrate themselves and foster a devotion to His Sacred Heart:

- I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- I will establish peace in their homes.
- I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- I will bless every place in which an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.
- I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.
- I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.
