Ash Wednesday and Good Friday Days of Fasting and Abstinence: Every person between the age of 18 and 59 beginning of the 60th year must fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and good Friday. The law of fasting allows a single full meal each day and two light meals at other times but no solid foods between meals. *No meat is allowed on any Friday during lent.*
