Bishop Strickland announces 'Nineveh Fast' to make reparation for 'grave sins'

This effort will begin on Friday, March 27th, and will continue on the fourth Friday of each month, for the next eight months – for a total of nine days of fasting.

Each of these days will be offered:

In reparation for grave sins – especially those committed against the innocent.

In petition for God's mercy upon our nation and our world.

In prayer for healing for those who have suffered abuse and exploitation.

And in supplication for the conversion of hearts – especially those in positions of influence.

This is an invitation to all. The great and the small. The known and the unknown. Just as in Nineveh.

How should this fast be observed? Each according to their ability.

Some may undertake a stricter fast – bread and water. Others

may follow the traditional practice: One full meal ... and two smaller meals. And for those unable to fast from food, other sacrifices may be offered. But it must be united to prayer.

We encourage: Holy Mass, The Rosary, The Divine Mercy Chaplet Eucharistic Adoration, The Divine Office, Spiritual reading Because fasting without prayer becomes only hardship. Go to NinevehNovena.org

If you are reading this after March 27th, start on the next Friday with your fast and then continue on the 4th Friday of each month. Or you could start on April 24th and continue for the next 8 months. God is outside of time and will bless your efforts.

KC HALL

A Columbus NE facility that has been a popular site for weddings, meetings, parties, dances and even as a voting location for elections, has closed. The Columbian Club meeting and event hall at 3115 6th St, locally known as the KC Hall, opened in 1962 and was built primarily to serve the members of the Knights of Columbus Council #938 which was originally comprised of members from all three Columbus parishes and even from some of the surrounding area parishes. The hall was also made available for community events.

Recently the facility was donated by the Columbian Club Corporation to the Columbus Catholic Schools (CCS). In his acknowledgement letter to the Columbian Club board and KC Council #938 for the donation, CCS Executive Directory, Jeff Ohnoutka shared the following: "...This generous donation is more than just a transfer of property; it is a profound investment in the future of our students and the mission of our schools. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy as a Novena begins on Good Friday, April 3 thru Saturday, April 11.

"On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the house of My Father..."

"On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My bitter Passion, for graces for these souls."

(Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, each day, for the following daily intention.)

FIRST DAY "Today bring to Me ALL MANKIND, ESPECIALLY ALL SINNERS."

SECOND DAY "Today bring to Me THE SOULS OF PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS."

THIRD DAY "Today bring to Me ALL DEVOUT AND FAITHFUL SOULS."

FOURTH DAY "Today bring to Me THOSE WHO DO NOT BELIEVE IN ME AND THOSE WHO DO NOT YET KNOW ME."

FIFTH DAY "Today bring to Me THE SOULS OF THE SEPARATED BRETHREN."

SIXTH DAY "Today bring to Me THE MEEK AND HUMBLE SOULS AND THE SOULS OF LITTLE CHILDREN."

SEVENTH DAY "Today bring to Me THE SOULS WHO ESPECIALLY VENERATE AND GLORIFY MY MERCY."

EIGHTH DAY "Today bring to Me THE SOULS WHO ARE DETAINED IN PURGATORY."

NINTH DAY "Today bring to Me SOULS WHO HAVE BECOME LUKEWARM."
