1. News is spreading quickly about the **Jubilee Year of St. Francis**, proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV, that began Jan.10, 2026, and continues to Jan. 10, 2027. The Holy Father is bringing the world's attention to the Saint of Assisi to coincide with the 800th anniversary of his death. Why is St. Francis needed in the Church and world today? Br. William Short, OFM, a medieval historian and expert on Franciscan spirituality, says the jubilee year is a time to reflect on the life and death of Francis, who was canonized a saint only two years after his passing.
