- With partners, vendors, consultants, service providers, contractors, or our related entities who need access to such information to carry out work or perform services on our behalf.
- With strategic partners who provide additional features on the Sites. These strategic relationships may include business partners, sponsors and co-branded Site features. The use of your information by these third parties is subject to their own privacy practices and you should check their website for information regarding their privacy policies.
- As may be permitted or required by law (including, but not limited to, court order or subpoena), or to prevent or investigate suspected fraud, violations of any agreement we have with you, or activity that appears to us to be illegal or may expose us to legal liability.
- In response to a request for information, if we believe disclosure is in accordance with or required by, any applicable law, court order, rule, regulation or legal process.

- In connection with enforcement of any agreement we may have with you.
- Between and among St. Isidore and any current or future parent, subsidiary, and/or affiliated St. Isidore.
- With your consent or at your direction.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provided such information.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- As otherwise would, under the circumstances, be reasonably expected by a consumer.

We also may share aggregated or de-identified information, which cannot reasonably be used to identify you and is not subject to this Policy.

THIRD-PARTY LINKS

In an attempt to provide you with increased value, we may include third-party links on our Sites. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third-party's website. We have no control over these linked sites. Each third-party site has its own separate and independent privacy policies and practices, including in connection with their use or disclosure of information you disclose to them. St. Isidore is not responsible or liable for the content of any third-party site. We encourage you to check the privacy policies of third-party sites before providing your information to them. The fact that we may link to a third-party site or present a banner ad or other type of advertisement from a third party is not an endorsement, authorization, or representation of any affiliation by us with that third-party, nor is it an endorsement of their privacy or information security policies or practices.

THIRD-PARTY ANALYTICS SERVICES

We may work with certain third parties to collect, analyze, and use some of the information described above.
