INVITATION TO BID NEW TRACK TYPE EXCAVATOR

The Carroll County Water Authority ("CCWA") is seeking bids from interested and qualified dealers to furnish one (1) new 2025 track type excavator (9,500-11,000 GW) on a one-time basis.

I. Instructions to Bid

A. How to Prepare Bid Proposals:

- Bidders should complete Attachments 1 through 4 for the excavator they are willing to provide CCWA under the Terms and Conditions of this Invitation to Bid. Excavator shall meet the minimum specifications outlined in Section III. All prices should be F.O.B. Destination. Delivery address is provided in Section II. Bidders shall also provide any manufacturer specifications or technical data with their submittals.
- 2. All bid proposals shall be typewritten or completed with pen, signed by the vendor or their authorized representative, with all erasures or corrections initialed and dated by the official signing the proposal. Bidders are encouraged to review carefully all provisions and attachments of this document prior to completion. Each bid constitutes an offer and may not be withdrawn except as provided herein. Also, prices are to remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days from opening date.
- B. How to Submit Bid Proposals: All bid proposals shall be:
 - Submitted and marked with "Bid NEW TRACK TYPE EXCAVATOR"
 - 2. Mailed, delivered or emailed as follows in sufficient time to ensure receipt by the Purchasing Agent before **2:00 P.M. Thursday, August 14, 2025**.

(d) No proposals will be received or accepted after 2:00 P.M. ET, local time, August 14, 2025. Proposals received after the designated date and time will be deemed

invalid and returned unopened to the bidder. CCWA is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail, email or proposal. It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure the bid is submitted and received in accordance with this specifications and prior to the deadline. No proposal may be withdrawn within sixty days after the proposal's opening and shall remain firm through the period.

- C. <u>How to Submit an Objection</u>: Objections from bidders to the invitation to bid and/or these specifications should be brought to the attention of the Purchasing Agent in the following manner.
 - 1. Written objections should be received at least 5 days prior to the opening of the bids.
 - 2. Failure to object in accordance with the above procedure shall constitute a waiver on the part of the vendor to protest the solicitation.
- D. <u>Standards for Acceptance of Bid for Awarded Contract</u>: CCWA reserves the right to waive any informality, to reject any and all bids, to disregard nonconforming, nonresponsive or conditional bids, to evaluate all bids, to accept portions of any bid and to accept any bid which in its opinion is in the best interests of CCWA. **CCWA reserves the right to modify the contract/purchase order after its award.**
- E. <u>Compliance with laws</u>: The bidder shall obtain and maintain all licenses, permits, liability insurance, workman's compensation insurance and comply with any and all other standards or regulations required by federal, state or county statute, ordinances and rules during the performance of any contract between the bidder and CCWA. Any such requirement specifically set forth in any contract document between the bidder and CCWA shall be supplementary to this section and not in substitution thereof.

II. General Terms and Conditions

- A. <u>Specifications</u>: Any obvious error or omission in specifications shall not inure to the benefit of the bidder but shall put the bidder on notice to inquire of or identify the same from CCWA. Whenever mention is made of any article, material, or workmanship to be in accordance with laws, ordinances, building codes, underwriter's codes, A.S.T.M. regulations or similar expressions, the requirements of these laws, ordinances, etc., shall be construed to be the minimum requirements of these specifications.
- B. <u>Delivery Point</u>: All items shall be quoted and delivered F.O.B. Destination to the following address:

Delivery cost and charges (if any) will be included in bid price.

C. <u>Delivery Time</u>: Estimated delivery dates should be stated on the bids. Delivery time may be considered by CCWA when selecting most responsive and responsible bidder.

- D. <u>Bids for All or Part</u>: Unless otherwise specified by CCWA or by the bidder, **CCWA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE AWARD ON ALL ITEMS, OR ON ANY OF THE ITEMS ACCORDING TO THE BEST INTEREST OF CCWA.**
- E. <u>Prices to be Firm</u>: Bidder warrants that bid prices, terms and conditions quoted in their bid will be firm for acceptance for a period of sixty (60) days from opening date.
- F. <u>Description of Excavator</u>: Proposals for excavator and/or equipment should be accompanied by copies of detailed factory specifications, ratings, technical data, including accurate descriptions of the exact excavator and/or equipment on which bids are made.
- G. <u>Completeness</u>: All information required by Invitation to Bid must be completed and submitted to constitute a proper bid.
- H. Quality: All materials used for the manufacture or construction of excavator and/or equipment covered by this bid shall be new, the latest model, of the best quality and highest-grade workmanship. Excavator and/or equipment shall be equipped with such necessary equipment complying with the Georgia State Law, but not including licensing. Also, materials must comply with all applicable Federal and State OSHA requirements in affect at the time of bid.
- Acceptance of Material: The material delivered under this proposal shall remain the property of
 the seller until a physical inspection and actual usage of this material and/or services is made
 and therefore accepted to the satisfaction of CCWA.
- J. <u>Guarantee/Warranty</u>: The bidder shall state the warranty in the proposal. All warranty repairs and adjustments shall be made only at such time as will be least detrimental to the operation of CCWA business.
- K. <u>Manufacture or Dealer Advertisement</u>: No manufacturer or dealer advertising attachments shall appear on products delivered to the CCWA without prior approval by CCWA.
- L. <u>Brand Name</u>: If and whenever brand names, makes, name of manufacturers, trade names, vendor catalogs or model numbers are stated, they are for the purpose of establishing a grade or quality of material.
- M. <u>"OR EQUAL" Interpretation</u>: When an "or equal" substitution is acceptable to CCWA for consideration, it is the vendor's responsibility to prove to CCWA that each bid item is equal to the grade or quality of material specified. CCWA reserves the right to deny "or equal" substitutions.
- N. <u>Award of Contract/Purchase Order</u>: The contract/purchase order, if awarded, will be awarded to the most responsive and responsible bidder whose bid will be most advantageous to CCWA based on factors including but not limited to price, estimated delivery, warranty, and prior experience with similar equipment and manufacturer.
- O. <u>Qualified Vendor</u>: A "Qualified Vendor" is defined for this purpose as one who meets, or by the date of bid acceptance can meet, all requirements for licensing, insurance and service contained within these specifications.

- P. <u>Compliance with Specifications Terms and Conditions</u>: The Invitation to Bid, Legal Advertisement, General Conditions and Instructions to Bidder, Specifications, Special Conditions, Vendor's Bid, Addendum, and/or any other pertinent documents form a part of this proposal and by reference are made a part hereof.
- Q. <u>Signed Bid Considered Offer</u>: The signed bid shall be considered an offer on the part of the bidder, which offer shall be deemed accepted upon approval by the CCWA Board of Directors. In case of a default on the part of the bidder after such acceptance, CCWA may take such actions as it deems appropriate including legal action for damages or specific performance.

- U. Previous model year excavators (new, never titled) may be considered if available.
- V. Business License Requirement: Dealership shall be licensed to do business.
- W. All equipment must be accompanied by a factory recommended preventative maintenance schedule including procedures, hour intervals and fluid specifications.
- X. **Certification of Independent Price Determination:** By submission of this bid, the bidder certifies that in connection with this Invitation to Bid:
 - 1. The prices in this bid have been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication' or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other bidder or with any competitor;
 - 2. Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed by the bidder prior to opening, directly or indirectly to any other bidder or to any competitor;
 - 3. No attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person or firm to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition; and
 - 4. No agent or employee of CCWA has been provided any compensation, goods or promise in connection with this bid solicitation.

III. EXCAVATOR REQUIRED BY THE CCWA WITH SPECIFIC SPECIFICATIONS

A. CCWA requires one (1) Track Type Excavator (9,500-11,000 GW). The excavator will primarily be used for installing and repairing water and sewer infrastructure.

B. Excavator must comply with Federal and State laws and regulations as applicable on date of delivery concerning equipment and conditions and will be complete with standard equipment and all extra equipment as specified.
