- A. Cherry & Almond Cake
(made to a given recipe)

Ingredients:

8oz/225gm soft margarine
8oz/225gm caster sugar
4 large eggs
8oz/225gm plain flour
Half teasp ground cinnamon
Half teasp ground mace
1lb/450gm mixed fruit (currents, sultanas and raisins)

3oz/85gm glace cherries, quartered
2oz/55gm mixed peel

Topping:

2oz/55gm glace cherries, quartered
2oz/55gm mixed peel
1oz/30gm flaked almonds

Method:

Grease and line 8in/20cm cake tin. Cream margarine and sugar together, until light in colour, beat eggs into mixture. Stir in the sieved flour and spices and finally the fruit. Spoon mixture into the prepared tin.

For the topping:

Mix together the cherries, peel and almonds and sprinkle over the surface of the cake. Cook in slow oven, 150°C (130° Fan), 300°F, Gas Mark 2 for about 2½ hours and allow to cool slightly before turning out.
