The monetary award will be forwarded to the selected post-secondary institution upon documentation (student ID and proof of registered classes) obtained by the student from the school that the recipient is currently enrolled in. The awardee must use the scholarship funds for tuition, required educational institution fees, and/or other direct course-related expenses required of all students enrolled in during instruction.
- 5. Applicant must NOT be immediate family members of directors or employees of United Way of Citrus County.
- 6. The scholarship winner will grant United Way and Women United social media permission to allow them to post the recipients picture with the scholarship award.

Criteria Checklist:

1.	The applicant must be a Citrus County resident of at least one year.		
2.	The applicant must be a graduating senior, be enrolled in an accredited four-year college/university		
	two-year college or technical school in Florida, and begin his/her post-secondary education in the 2024-2025		
	academic year.		
3.	The transcript of the applicant must be submitted and include the current GPA. The applicant's GPA		
	must be at least a 3.0 unweighted.		
4.	Leadership and Community Involvement: List all participation and contributions to extracurricular		
	activities, the community, and the workforce, if applicable.		
5.	References:		
	a. Two letters of reference are required.		
	b. References may come from a teacher, advisor, guidance counselor, school administrator, employer,		
	clergy, a person with whom the student has done volunteer or community work, or any other adult wh		
	is aware of the applicant's background.		
6.	Essay (500 words or less): The applicant must write an essay explaining why he or she is seeking this		
	scholarship, why he or she wants to attend college/trade school, his or her major or focus of study, financial		
	need, goals for the future, and what challenges he or she faces in continuing on to post-secondary education.
