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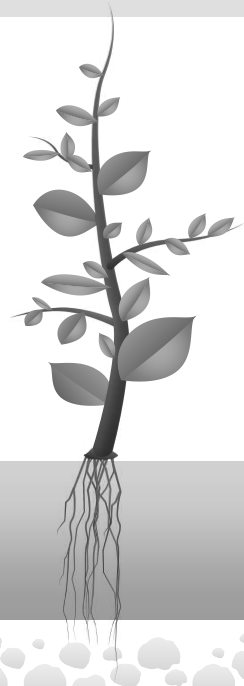

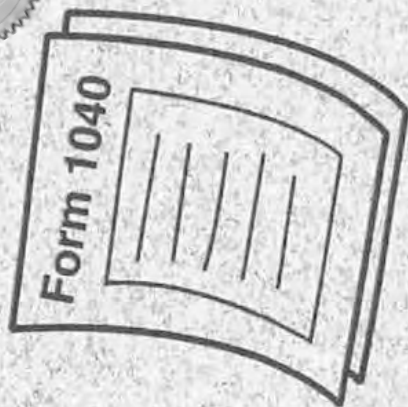

Mary Moody

Mary Moody has been chosen by the Old Hallowell Day Committee as the 2026 Citizen of the Year. Mary was born in Downeast Maine and has been a resident of Hallowell since 1969. After getting her degree in education, she was offered jobs in Van Buren and Hallowell. She chose Hallowell and worked at the Stevens School until it closed before going on to work for the Department of Education.



Mary is a lifelong volunteer. She has been a trustee of Row House, Inc., Hallowell's Historical Society, since 1990 and has served terms as a past President and the current Treasurer. She is a former member of the Community Development Committee and served on the School Board and Christmas in Old Hallowell Committee. She advocates for the disabled, works on accessible parking in Hallowell, is involved with the Levinson Center in Bangor, and is current President of ARCH Beta Housing. She has managed numerous charitable public suppers for Sacred Heart Church, Row House, the Hubbard Free Library, and Old Hallowell Day.

Mary describes Hallowell as a welcoming community where people are friendly and willing to help as needed. She felt immediately embraced by the community when she moved here in her early twenties. Hallowell is very lucky that Mary has chosen to spend her life here. The Old Hallowell Day Committee is pleased to name Mary Moody as our Citizen of the Year.

Lily Drouin-Scease

Lily Drouin-Scease has been chosen by the Old Hallowell Day Committee as the 2026 Barry S. Timson Community Service Award recipient for her clear and lasting commitment to our community through service, leadership, and environmental stewardship.

Lily is a recent graduate of Hall-Dale High School where she was a member of the Key Club, Student Senate, National Honor Society, and Tri-M Music Council. As a member of the Key Club, she was involved in service work that reflects her willingness to give time to others.



Lily has a passion for both music and the outdoors. She plays the violin and viola and was one of ~70 students statewide chosen to play in the Classical All-State Orchestra. She has participated in various Chewonki expeditions including canoeing on the Allagash River and backpacking through both the Hundred-Mile Wilderness and in the remote Gaspé Peninsula. Her favorite trip was a whitewater trip in a remote area of Quebec. For her senior capstone, Lily focused on stream ecology. She volunteered with the Hallowell Conservation Commission traveling through Hallowell to monitor watershed health. A lesson she learned is the importance of listening to the concerns of landowners and other community stakeholders along the watershed.

Lily plans to attend Bowdoin College, majoring in Environmental Studies. If you see Lily, please congratulate her as she will likely be unable to attend the award ceremony or parade. 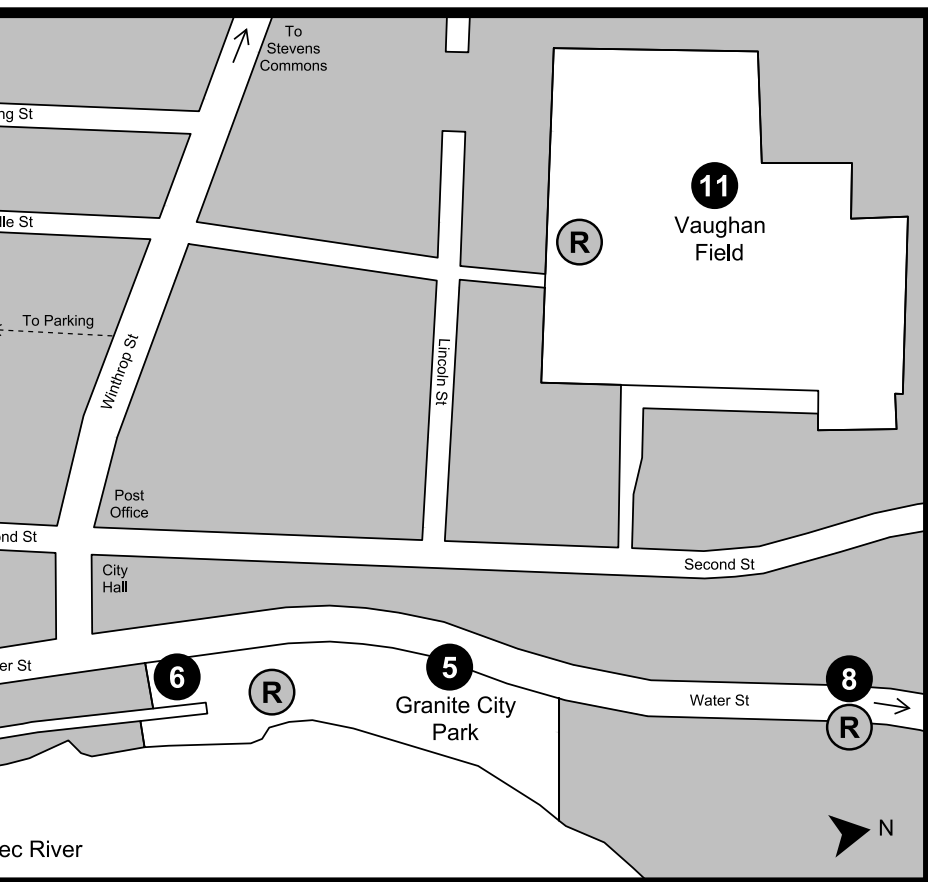

In Memoriam: Dennis Kinney

August 1954–March 2026



Hallowell lost one of its own this March — a man whose fingerprints are on Hallowell, Old Hallowell Day, and its summer night sky.

For more than 30 years, Dennis served as superintendent of the Hallowell Water District, steward of a system whose roots go back to 1797. Keeping it running — through cold winter nights, aging pipes, and all the work it required — required vision, expertise, and commitment. Dennis had it all in abundance.

Shortly after moving to Hallowell, he set about putting on a fireworks show the city had never seen — raising the money, building the equipment, and constructing the pyrotechnic signs that spelled out Old Hallowell Day. The day after the show, he would start working on next year's show to outdo the previous year.

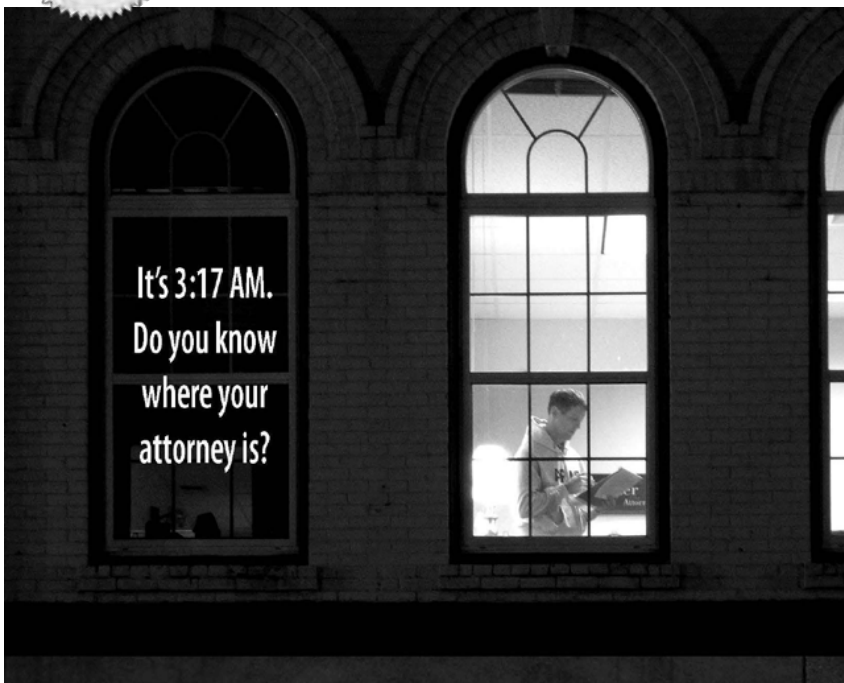

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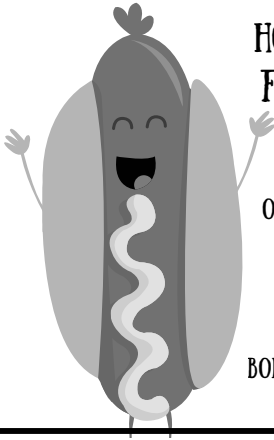

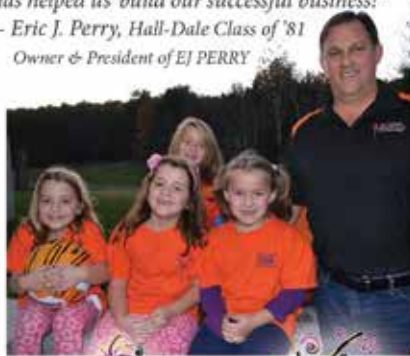
