Welcome to Lake City—and welcome to the 2026 ArtFields Festival!

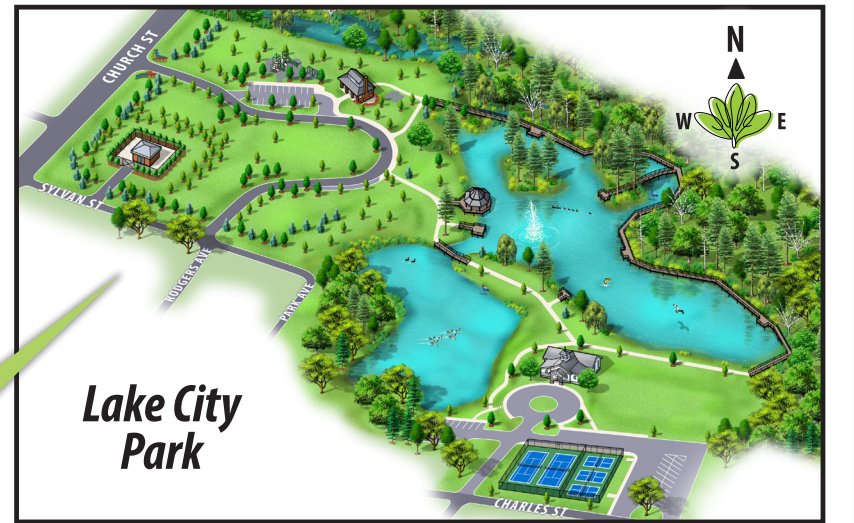

gallery exhibitions, and an ever-growing collection of public art.

As you explore Lake City—through our boutique shops, barber shops, galleries, and repurposed venues—be sure to venture beyond the festival spaces and discover the incredible public art featured on this map.

While ArtFields venues and nearby Moore Farms Botanical Garden are closed on Sundays and Mondays (April 10–May 2), this guide invites you to continue your experience outdoors. Use it to explore at your own pace and enjoy the art, the lake, and the beauty of Lake City—open and waiting for you 24/7.

Lake City is located at the western tip of the northern branch of Lynchess Lake.

This series of lakes is cited as the home area of many patriots in General Francis Marion's Brigade.

Lake City Park features a 12-acre lake with a boardwalk, five fishing piers, canoe/kayak launch, shaded gazebo, a picnic shelter with a wood-burning fireplace, restrooms, and more.

The North Eastern Railroad completed their north-south line with a freight depot built in 1858. It was previously located just West of the Main St. & Acline Ave. intersection (I-7).
