KATE ZANKOWICZ & BOB BLUMER

Canadian television personality, author, and culinary creative Bob Blumer is best known as the creator and host of the Food Network shows *The Surreal Gourmet*, *Glutton for Punishment*, *and World's Weirdest Restaurants*. He is also the author and illustrator of seven cookbooks, including his most recent, *Flavorbomb*: A *Rogue Guide to Making Everything Taste Better*. Born and raised in Montreal, Bob brings the same mix of artistry and heart to everything he does.

Dr. Kate Zankowicz, an educator and researcher, combines her academic background with deep compassion and a lifelong dedication to children's causes.

Together, Kate and Bob have opened their hearts and home to children who travel to Los Angeles for surgery through Mending Kids. Known lovingly as "Mama Kate" and "Daddy Bob," they have created a space of comfort and care for kids facing life-changing procedures far from their families.

For their unwavering kindness, advocacy, and humanity, we honor Kate and Bob with the HOPE Award — a recognition of their steadfast commitment to standing by our kids when they need family the most.



Mending Kids provides free life-saving surgical care to sick children worldwide by deploying volunteer medical teams and supporting communities to become medically self-sustaining.

Since 2005, thanks to our dedicated volunteer surgical teams from world- renowned medical institutions, we have mended nearly 6000 children from 78 countries, including over 155 kids in the United States and 210 surgical mission trips.



KEYLA'S STORY

When we first learned about Keyla, she was a little girl in El Salvador whose heart was failing. Her skin had turned blue from lack of oxygen, and time was running out.

Advocates reached out asking if we could help, but no hospital in the United States would take her case. Her condition was considered too complex, and pro bono care wasn't materializing. Without the imaging needed to make a treatment plan, and without the funds to cover surgery in the U.S., there was no clear path forward.

Months later, our team, led by **Dr. Jenny Zablah** from **Children's Hospital Colorado** and supported by the **Edwards Lifesciences Foundation**, traveled to El Salvador for a training mission. We reached out to Keyla's family, hoping to finally get the imaging that could determine if surgery was possible.



Her mother traveled from out of town to meet us, but after years of being told her daughter's condition was hopeless and that there was no help in El Salvador, she was terrified. She didn't want to let us proceed because her family hadn't had a chance to say goodbye, in case Keyla didn't survive the procedure.

It was a heartbreaking and frustrating delay. With every week and month that passed, Keyla's condition worsened. Still, we promised we would come back, and eight months later, when the stars aligned, we did. By then, Keyla was deeply cyanotic, but this time her mother said yes. Our team performed the diagnostic cath and another procedure to buy her more time. As the team watched, her lips went from blue to pink.

Keyla's journey is far from over, but her story embodies what Mending Kids stands for: caring for children when others can't, fighting for those considered too complex, and giving them the best chance at life — and a brighter future.






