


**Prattsburgh Wind LLC's
PRE-CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
MAY 2026**

This notice announces that, on or about May 4, 2026, Prattsburgh Wind, LLC (Prattsburgh or Permit Holder) will begin construction of an operations and maintenance (O&M) building in the Town of Cohocton to support the commencement of construction of the 152.1-megawatt (MW) Wind Energy Facility located in the Towns of Avoca, Cohocton, Howard, Prattsburgh, and Wheeler, Steuben County, NY (the Facility).

The Facility's Siting Permit for a Major Renewable Energy Facility, which was issued by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES) on September 24, 2024. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Prattsburgh Wind will construct the Facility in the Towns of Avoca, Cohocton, Howard, Prattsburgh, and Wheeler, Stueben County. When completed, the Facility will consist of up to 35 wind turbines with a total generating capacity of up to 152.1 megawatts (MW). Other proposed components will include access roads, overhead and buried 34.5-kilovolt (kV) collection lines, three temporary laydown/construction support areas, two permanent meteorological (met) towers, two temporary met towers, two aircraft detection lighting system (ADLS) towers, two temporary concrete batch plants, one operations and maintenance (O&M) building, and a medium-voltage to transmission voltage collector substation with associated equipment and fenced areas. The Permittee will also build and transfer to New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG) a new point of interconnection (POI) switching station, and approximately 1,400 feet of overhead transmission line to tie-in the Facility to the existing NYSEG Stoney Ridge to Canandaigua 230-kV transmission line #68.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin on or about May 4, 2026. Construction activities shall be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 8 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday and on national holidays.
