

KKR Global Private Credit Fund (KIT AUD)

31-July-2026

Innovative open-ended strategy that provides access to KKR's well-established private credit platform.

Underlying Fund portfolio update¹

In July, the Underlying Fund's strategy-level allocation sits at 34% European Direct Lending, 33% US Direct Lending, 27% Asset-Based Finance, 3% Traded Credit and 2% Asia Private Credit diversified across a total of 244 issuers (up month-over-month from 240) with the Underlying Fund Net Asset Value at US\$1,367 million.

In Direct Lending, KKR maintains a "sheltering-in-quality" posture with a median loan-to-value ratio of 38%², supported by mean and median high-performing borrowers with a mean and median EBITDA of US\$204 million and US\$137 million³. Top sectors include Software & Services, Financial Services, Commercial & Professional Services, Capital Goods, and Healthcare Equipment & Services.

Additionally, by rate type, the Underlying Fund's US and European Direct Lending strategies are approximately 99% floating-rate, while the Asset-Based Finance strategy provides both fixed rate and floating rate exposure. Consistent income generation (yield) remains one of the key drivers of performance return, evidenced by a current net distribution rate of approximately 9.1% in the Underlying Fund.

Overall, the portfolio's fair market value of investments is US\$2,287 million as of 31 July, 2026.

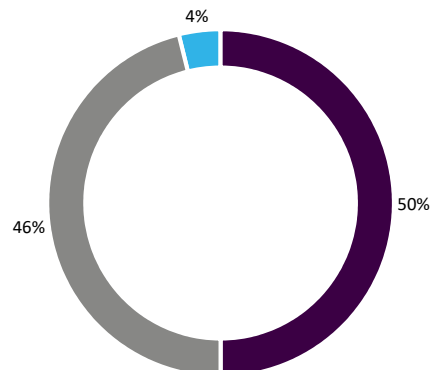
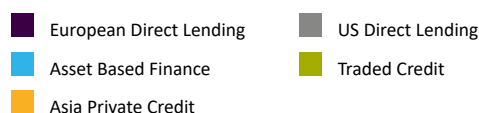
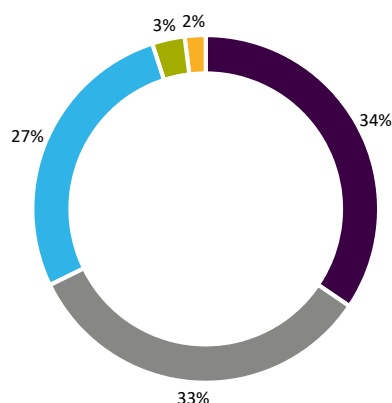
