Along the way, she encounters a series of spooky items that seem to follow her. The Books and Beats group picks up their performance during the last part of the story as the little old lady runs home. Once there, the clothing items assemble themselves into a friendly, not-so-scary scarecrow. The old lady then comes up with a clever idea: she sets the scarecrow up in her garden where it can scare the birds away. Ouring this semester, the Books and Beats group worked together to pick an instrument for each sound effect and wrote a song to accompany this repeated sequence in the book.
