**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ACCEPTING A PURPLE HEART HONOR
GARDEN SIGN ("SIGN") FROM HOLLY DOERING FOR PLACEMENT IN THE DESIGNATED
GARDEN AREA AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT AND HOLLY DOERING ESTABLISHING THE CONDITIONS OF THE
DISTRICT'S ACCEPTANCE OF THE SIGN**

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2024 the Board of Directors of the Bear Valley Community Services District ("District") signed a proclamation designating the District as a Purple Heart Community; and

WHEREAS, in May 2024, District staff with the assistance of Purple Heart recipients installed a road sign welcoming visitors to the District; and

WHEREAS, the concept of a Purple Heart Garden to honor Purple Heart Recipients and other veterans in the District was shared with staff; and

WHEREAS, Holly Doering has worked alongside the BVS Veterans Association, the Women's Auxiliary, the District, the Bear Valley Police Department, and the Bear Valley Springs Association to create the Purple Heart Garden; and

WHEREAS, Holly Doering desires to donate, and the District desires to accept the Purple Heart Garden Sign; and

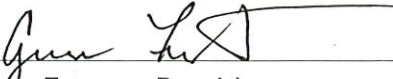
WHEREAS, the Purple Heart Garden Sign is a donation for a public purpose for the purpose of the District honoring Purple Heart recipients and veterans in the District; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Holly Doering to establish the conditions of the District's acceptance of the Purple Heart Garden Sign.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Bear Valley Community Services District does accept the Purple Heart Garden Sign from Holly Doering and authorize the General Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Holly Doering to establish the conditions of the District's acceptance of the Purple Heart Garden Sign.
