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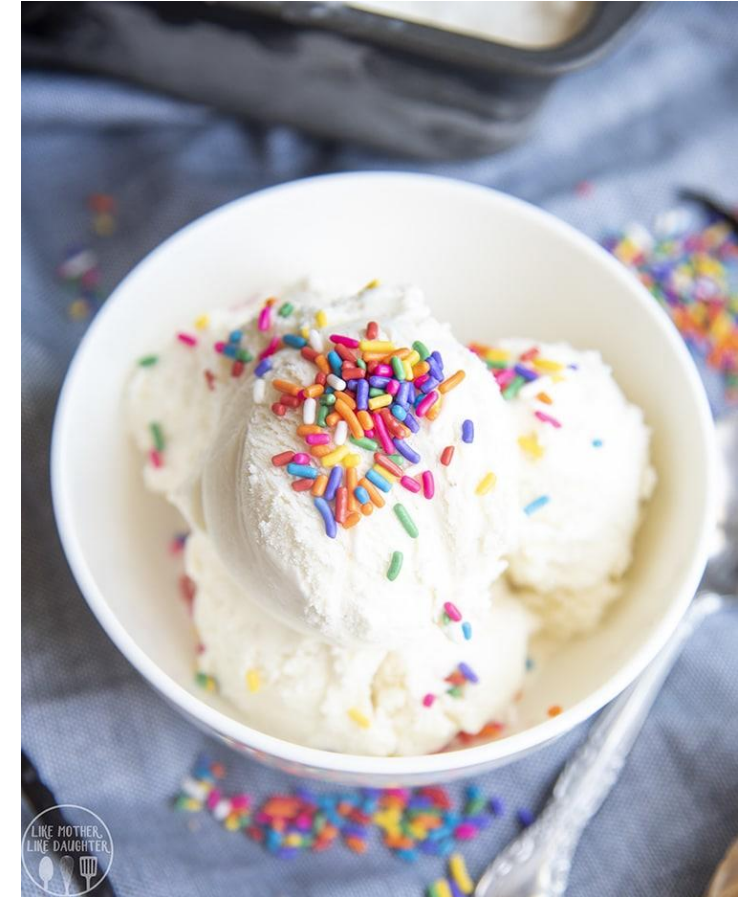

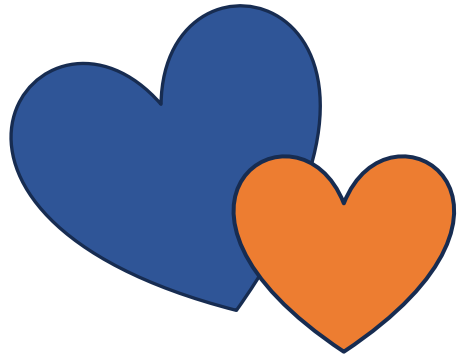

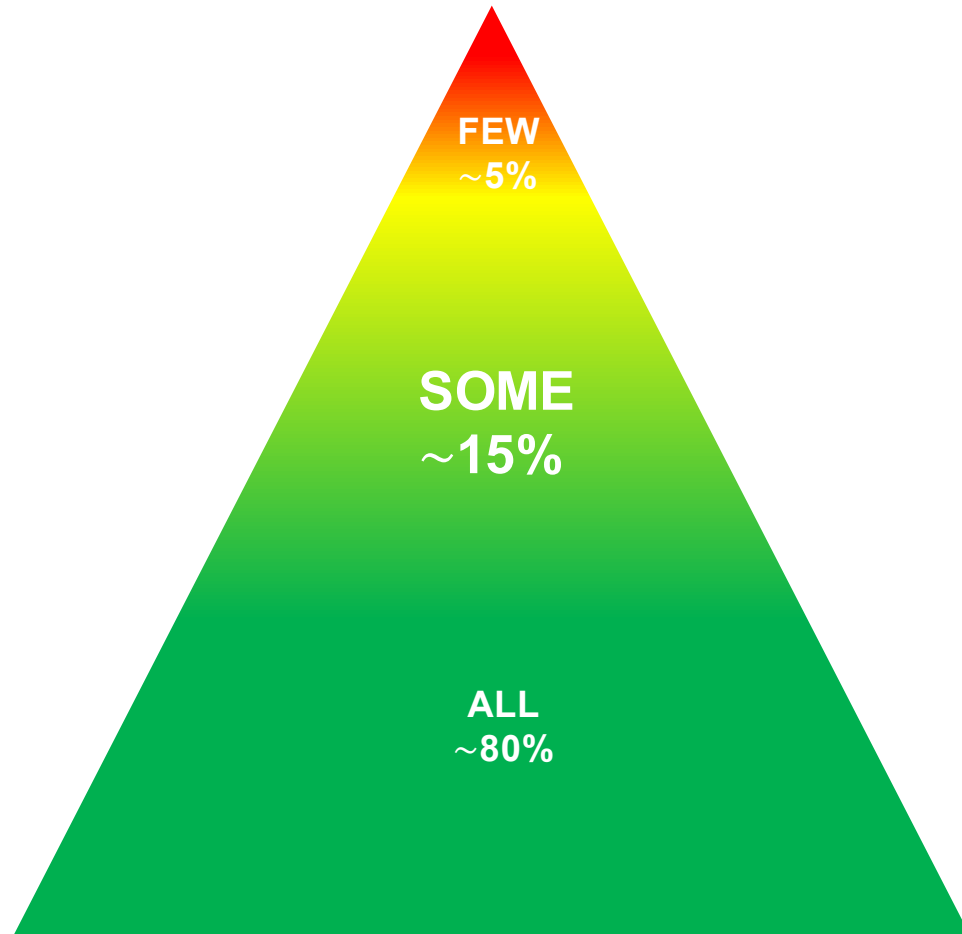
What is Tier 2 in PBIS/MTSS?

Tier 2 involves practices and systems designed to provide targeted interventions for students who struggle with Tier 1 supports alone.

- Focuses on addressing early signs of potentially serious behavioral issues, aiming to intervene before these behaviors escalate.
- Interventions at this level are more focused than Tier 1, but less intensive than Tier 3

- **Build on Tier 1:** Layer Tier 2 supports on top of a strong, universal foundation.
- **Targeted & timely:** Provide explicit, small-group interventions as soon as a need is identified.
- **Data-driven:** Use universal screening and frequent progress monitoring to match students to interventions and track growth.
- **Collaborative:** A team (including teachers, specialists, and families) identifies needs and develops a plan.
- **Evidence-based:** Use research-backed interventions implemented with consistency.

Levels of Support



Tier 3:

Intensive, Individualized Interventions & Supports

Most intense (*increased time, narrowed focus, reduced group size*) instruction and intervention based upon individual need

provided to a few in addition to and aligned with Tier 1 & 2 supports.

Tier 2:

Targeted, Supplemental Interventions & Supports

More targeted instruction/intervention and supplemental support **provided to some individuals** in addition to and aligned with Tier 1 the core curriculum.

Tier 1:

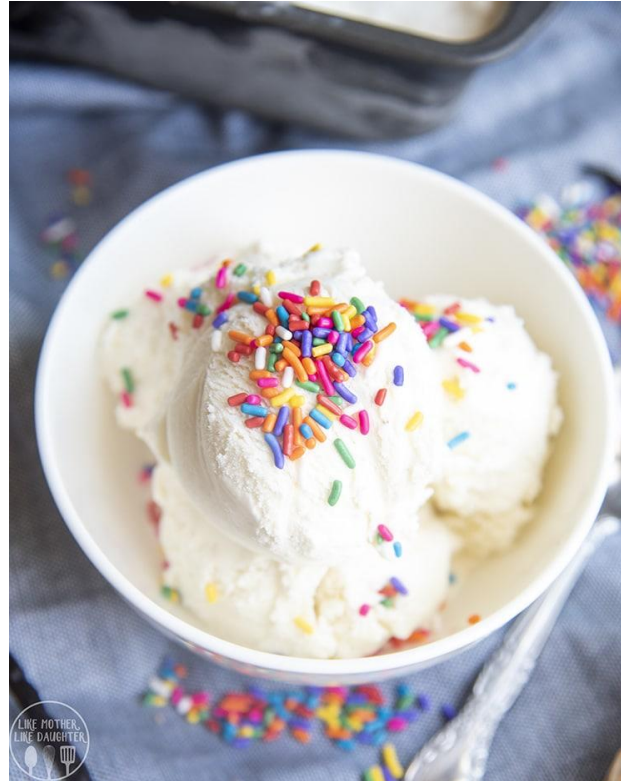
Core, Universal Instruction & Supports

General academic and social, emotional, behavioral instruction and support **provided to all** individuals in all settings.

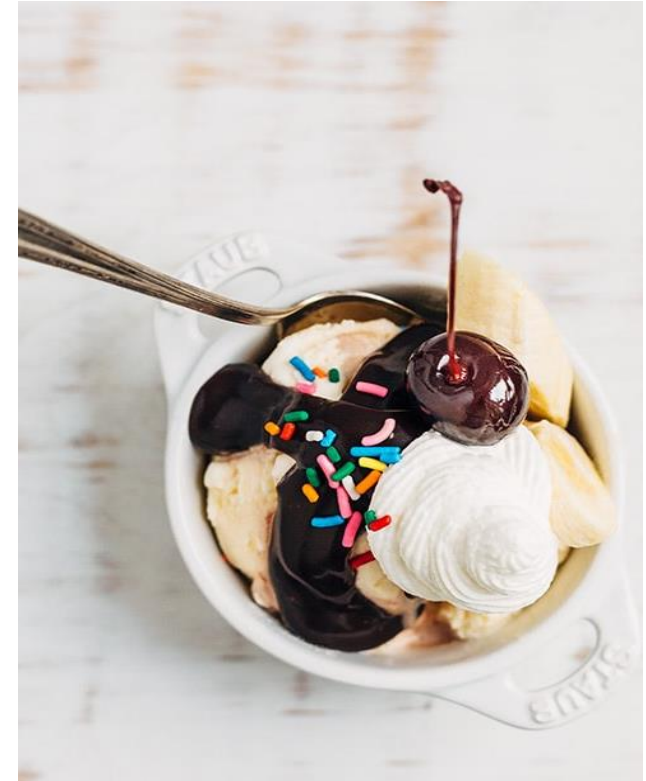

Why Invest in Tier 2 Interventions?



- **Core Idea:** Bridge the gap for students who need more than basic support but less than intensive, individual help.
- **Goal:** Address academic and behavioral gaps early to prevent them from escalating.
- **Outcome:** Create a more positive and inclusive learning environment for everyone

Key Benefits



- **Proactive & Preventative:** Address challenges early to minimize the need for more resource-intensive Tier 3 support later on.
- **Targeted Skill Building:** Teach and reinforce key academic and behavioral skills, such as social skills, self-regulation, and organization.
- **Improved School Climate:** Reduce disruptions and foster a more supportive classroom where students feel engaged and confident.
- **Data-Driven Decisions:** Use progress monitoring to ensure interventions are effective and adjusted as needed.

Goal of Tier 2 Interventions

Provide students with:

- More time and instruction for skill development
- More structure and predictability (during a routine/subject or across the day)
- Structured performance feedback
- Self-management skills (self-monitoring, self-instruction, self-correction)



What is in place in your school?

Data

- Collected and continuously monitored
- Are flexible and based on assessment

Systems

- Accessible within 72 hours of referral
- Aligned with school-wide expectations
- Are continuously available
- Require very low effort by teachers
- Can be supported with available resources
- Can be implemented by all staff/faculty in a school

Practices

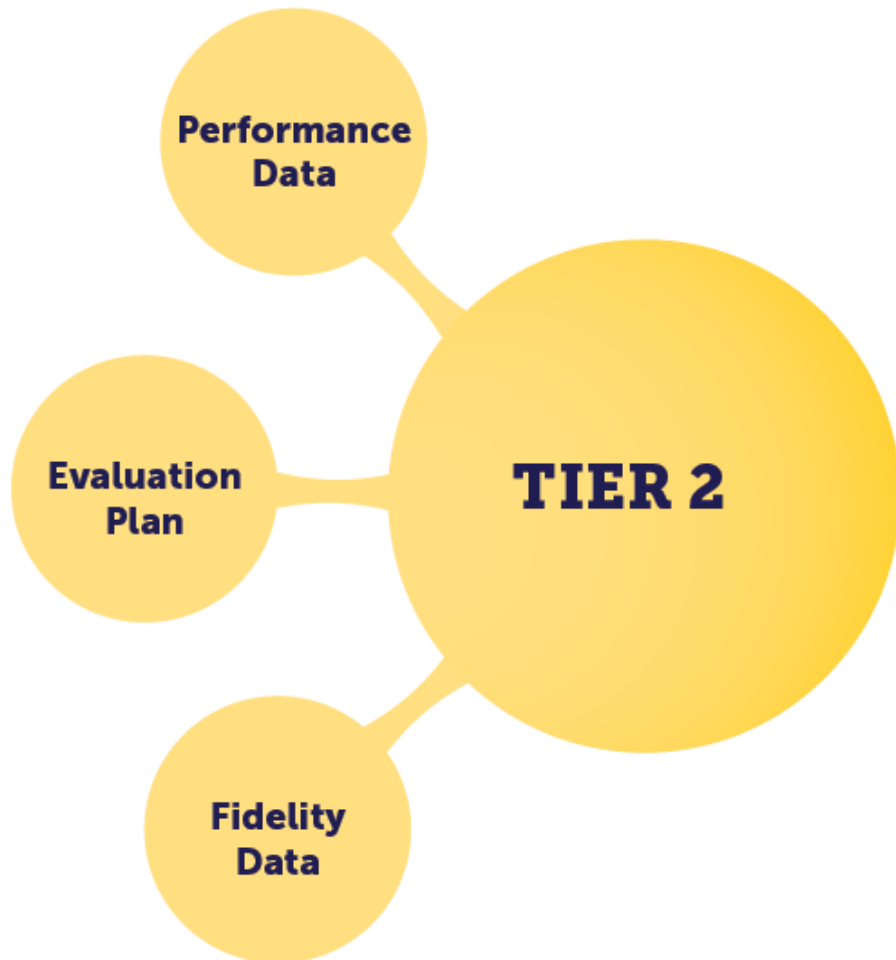
- Provide increased adult supervision
- Provide increased instruction and practice
- Increase opportunities for positive reinforcement
- Support student choice in participation
- Provide an increased focus on possible functions of behavior

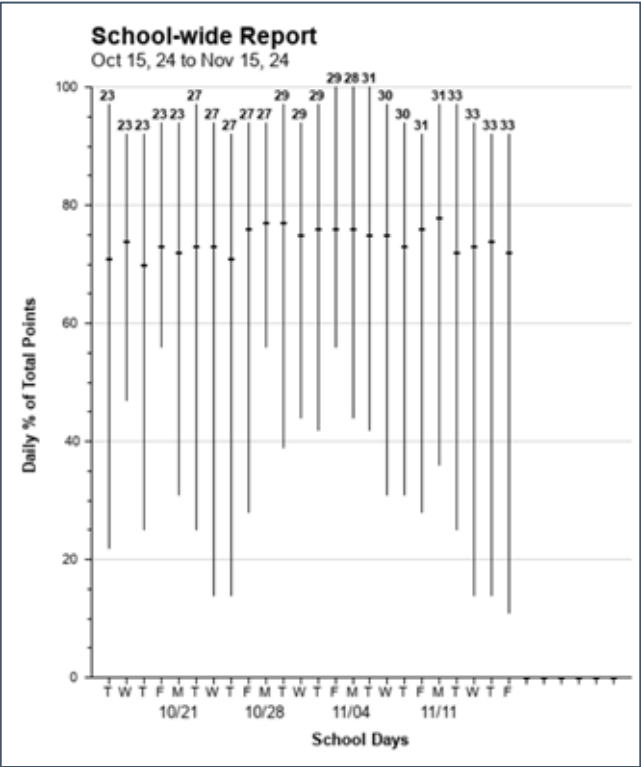


Performance: Are students achieving the outcomes we'd like to see?

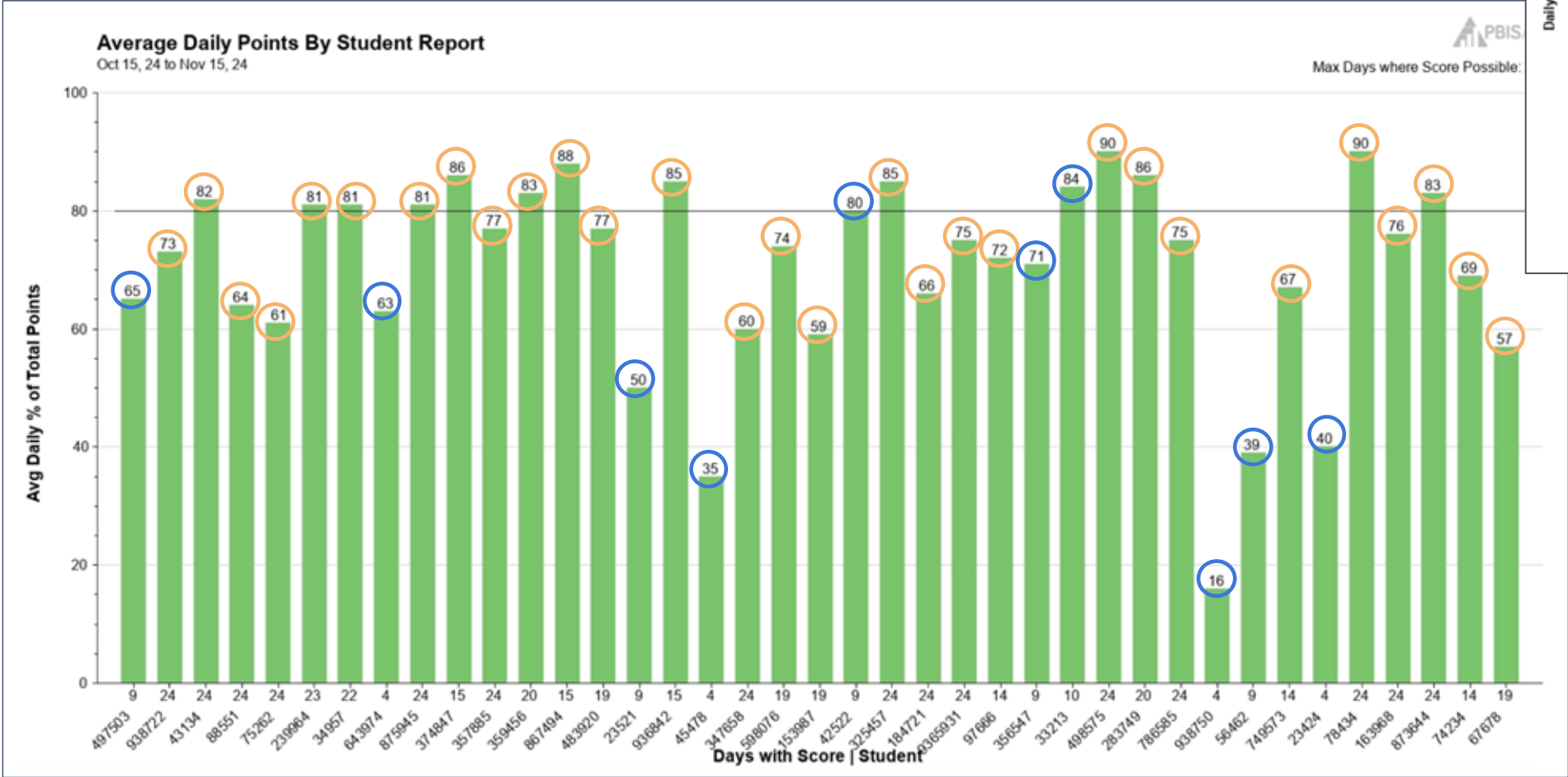
Evaluation: How are we sharing our outcomes and fidelity data with our community?

Fidelity: Are we (the adults) implementing the way we agreed to?

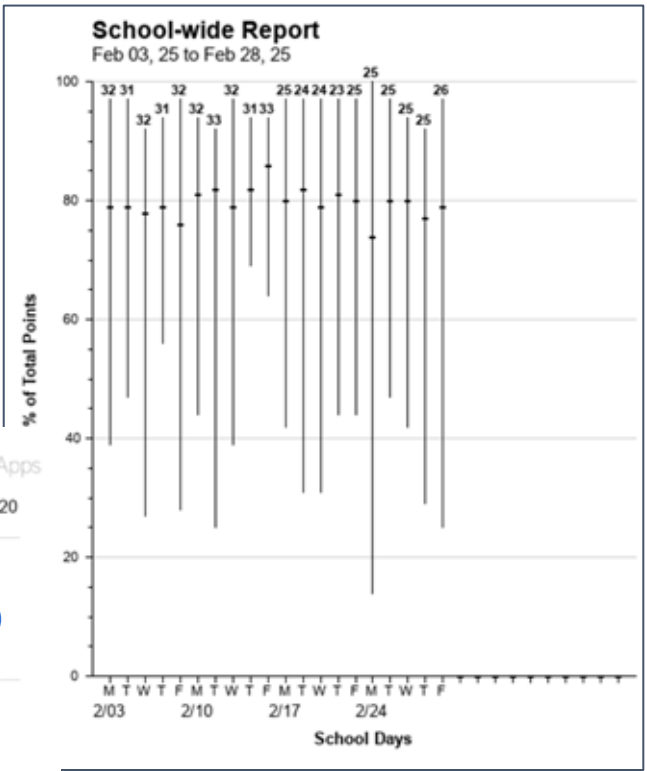
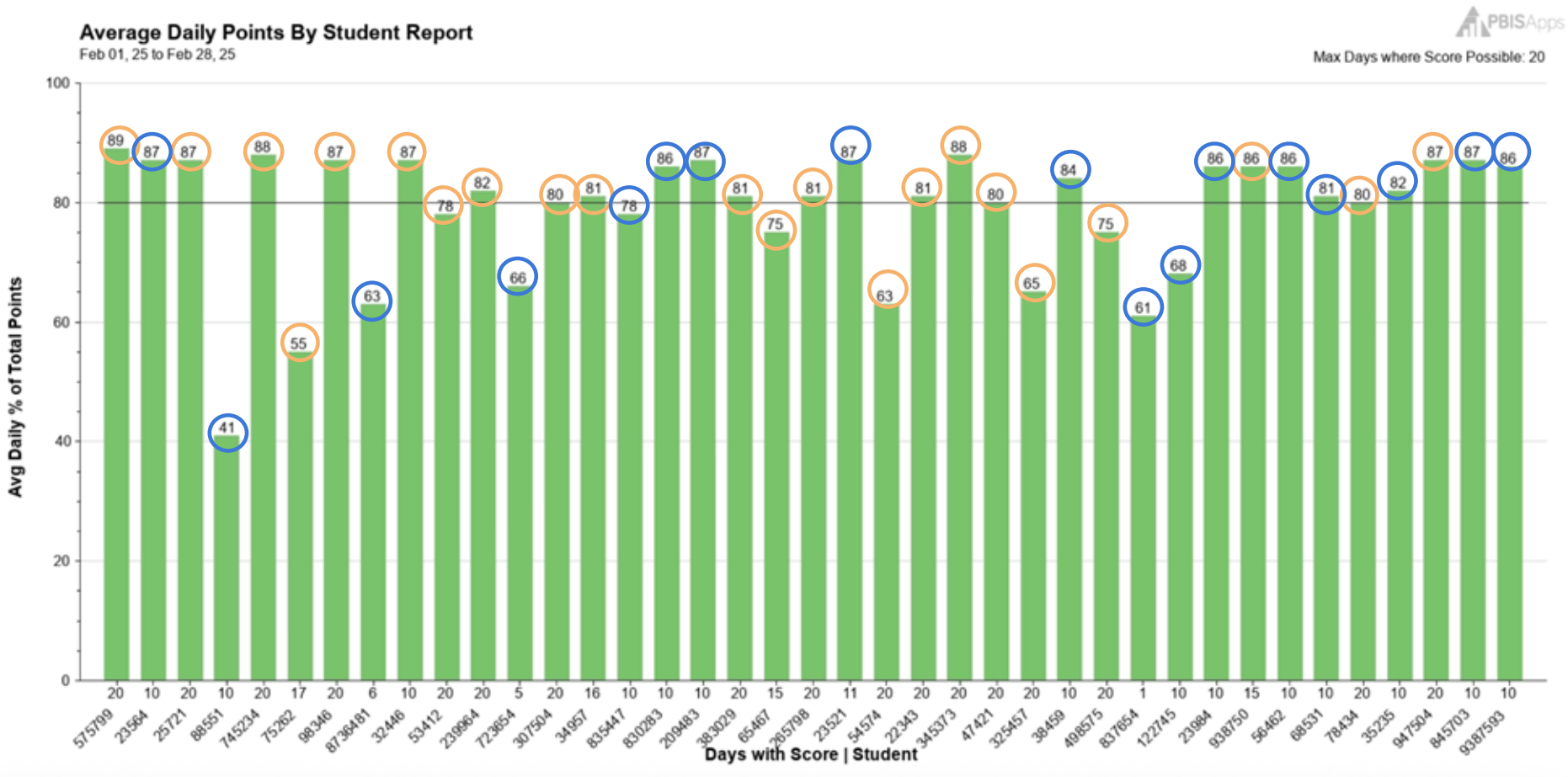
44.8% of students enrolled more than 2 weeks above 80%

69.2% of all students above 80%



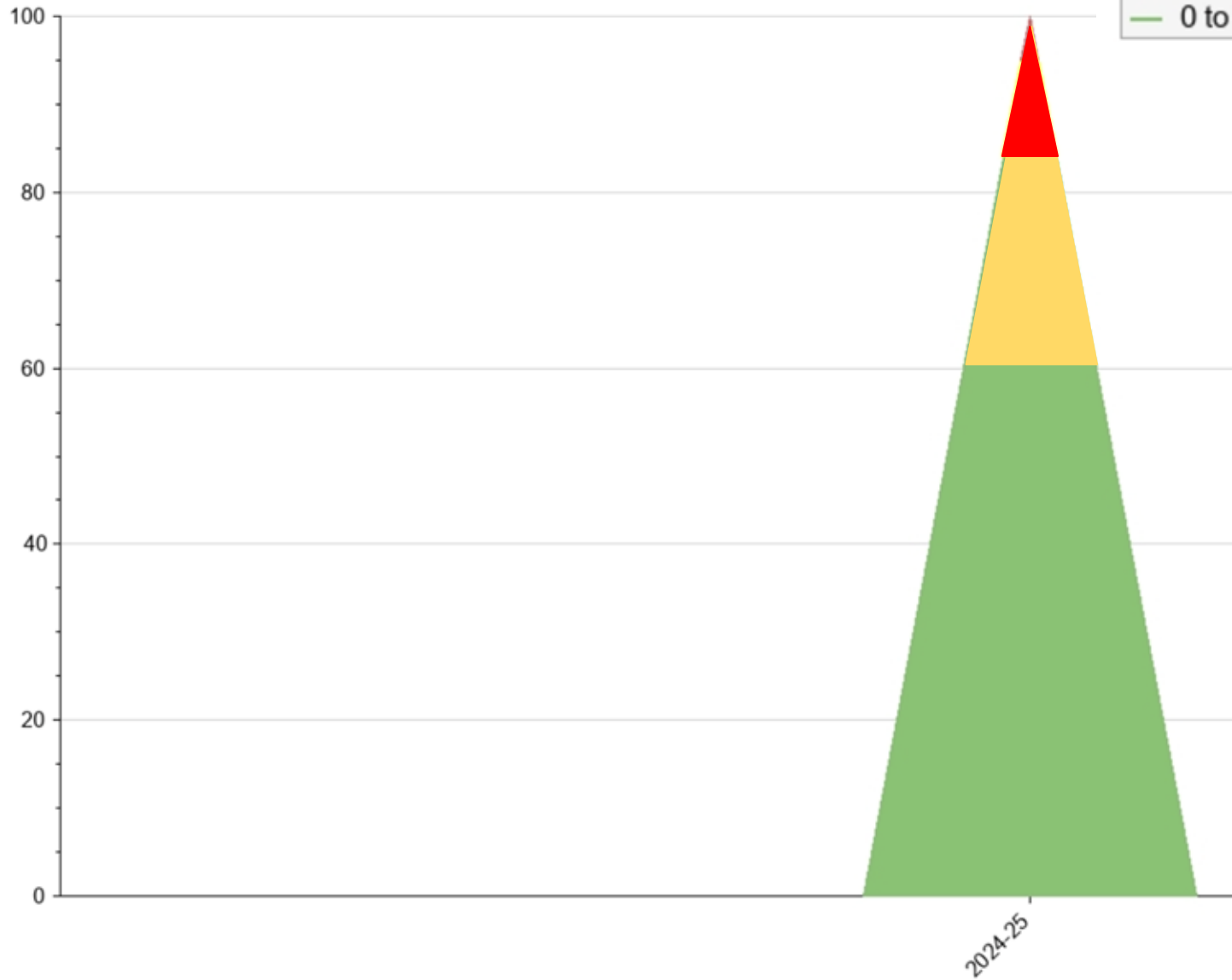
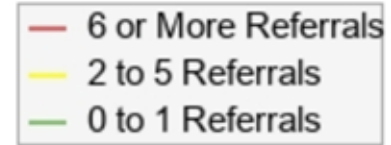
