Instructional Focus/Learning Targets

Literature: This month, students have continued to engage with our read aloud of Behind Rebel Lines by Seymour Reit, which tells the fictionalized story of Emma Edmonds, a Canadian-born girl who, disguised as a man, enlisted in the Union Army during the Civil War to fight for freedom and gather information behind enemy lines. We have deepened our learning by connecting this historical fiction to the real-life events of the drummer boys at Shiloh, and also composing a Civil War-era creative writing piece. Students have been diligently reading their Independent Novel and will complete their creative Independent Novel Project to demonstrate their comprehension of the text and its characters, themes, setting, and conflict. Additionally, students have been completing reflective writing to prepare for our Student Led Conferencing! We hope to see you there so your child can showcase their quality work with pride and professionalism!

Math: The instructional learning targets of the CSA middle school math curriculum focus on developing students' proficiency in key mathematical areas such as ratios, geometry, algebraic expressions, and statistics, while fostering critical thinking, problem-solving, and real-world application skills. The curriculum is designed to prepare students for high school math and beyond by encouraging a deep understanding of mathematical concepts.

Social Studies: This term, students will continue their journey through America's history by learning about the Civil War era. Students will analyze events leading up to the war, major battles and events during the war, as well as the Reconstruction time period. Students will also analyze the relationships between free and slave-holding states, as well as the policies and consequences of slavery and early attempts to abolish it. Finally, students will compare and contrast America before and after the Civil War. The unit will conclude with an oral or written assessment.

Advisory Program:

This month, our Advisory has focused on what it means to have and use a Growth Mindset. This perspective relies on Optimism to tell oneself: "I am capable of doing challenging things" or "I can try a new strategy to help me understand this concept better" or "Mistakes help me learn and improve." Framed within the context of using the growth mindset to achieve one's dreams, students reflected on how they can shift their thinking and words to achieve their goals and unlock their fullest potential!
