Common App - This is where seniors can apply to schools. In many cases they will be able to apply to multiple schools with the same information. There may be minor differences depending on the university.

The College Board - This is where seniors will be able to find and send their SAT and AP Scores to colleges and universities.

Parchment - This will allow seniors to send their transcripts to colleges and universities
