Focus of the Month: Internal Motivation

At CSA, we use Internal Motivation Psychology to help students grow into independent thinkers and responsible individuals. This approach encourages students to make positive choices, do their best, and discover the values that will guide them both in school and in life. We focus on creating supportive classrooms, building strong relationships, and modeling the character traits we expect students to show. We also teach routines and protocols so that students know what's expected and can succeed in a safe and respectful environment.

Uniform Policy Reminder

For All students:

- All-black shoes are required—please avoid white-soled tennis shoes.
 - Black or gray dress pants are required—no cargo pants, joggers, or yoga pants .
 - T-shirts and sweatshirts are not permitted
 - Shirts should be tucked in unless they are banded sweaters (no cropped tops).
 - Sweater sets are welcome, as long as they are sweater sets—not a T-shirt or tank top paired with a black cardigan.
 - Undergarments, including brightly colored T-shirts or shirts with words, should not be visible
 - Excessive jewelry is discouraged.
 - Skirts must be black or gray and no more than three inches above the knee (the height of a 3x5 card, for reference). They need to be neat and appropriately sized.
- When determining skirt length, a measurement should be taken from the natural waistline (not hips) to 3 inches above the knee of each individual.
