<u>Highlights from the Beluga</u> <u>Classroom</u>

-During the month of October we studied Nursery Rhymes and Pumpkins! We completed a KWL (what we know, want to learn and what we learned) chart. Students recited 9 famous Nursery Rhymes and then had a culminating event which included teaching a loved one what it's like to be in the Beluga classroom. We:

- Learning about pumpkins through the lens of a scientist
- · Primary and Secondary colors
- Completed a writing prompt answering the question, "What are you an expert at?" We worked on this over three days.
- Learned about 2D shapes beyond the most traditional ones. New ones; trapezoid, hexagon, pentagon and Octagon.
- Learned new math vocabulary; reverse number order, polygon, attributes and vertices.
- New sight words: like, can, my, and, was to name a few
- Used pictures to think about what we already know and talk about informational text.

As a class, we're going to make our own version of Stone Soup (yes there will be a stone!) and each child will have a chance to contribute to our vegetable style soup via sign up genius. 50th Day of School- 1950's Celebration

Part of our daily routine includes counting the days we've been in school. This gives children practice each day counting verbally, with one to one correspondence, and of course building number sense with tens and ones which will lead into place value. One of the milestones we celebrate with this activity is the 50th day of school! This will take place on Friday, November 14th. Students may come to school in 1950's style spirit wear including leather jackets, jeans, poodle skirts, patent leather saddle shoes, etc.

Character Corner Problem Solving:

In Beluga we talk a lot about solving problems by using our words. If you don't like something that is being said or done to you, then use your words and or use the hand motion telling the other student to please stop. Ask your child what the movement is for letting someone know you'd like them to please stop. We talk about how sometimes friends are trying to be silly with us and if we are laughing back then they don't know we don't like what they are doing or saying. Another way we use our words to solve problems is by checking in on friends if we accidentally hurt them or make a poor choice that affects another person. If this happens the child will go over, with support from the teacher if needed, and ask them if they are okay, if not they ask how they can fix it. Then the conversation between the two students will end by offering a hug, high five or hand shake to extend their apology.
