Focus of the Month: Empathy

At CSPA, we are fostering Habits of Mind in our classrooms to help students grow not just academically, but as thoughtful, reflective, and socially aware individuals. One key habit we focus on is "Listening with Understanding and Empathy."

This habit encourages students to:

- Truly hear and understand others' perspectives before responding.
- Consider the feelings and experiences behind someone's words.
- Engage respectfully and thoughtfully in discussions and group work.

Why it matters:

- Builds stronger peer and teacher relationships.
- Supports teamwork, collaboration, and problem-solving.
- Helps students navigate diverse ideas and viewpoints with respect.

In practice, students may paraphrase a peer's point, ask clarifying questions, or reflect on what they learned from another perspective. By practicing this habit, our students are not only improving communication skills but also preparing for life beyond the classroom, where empathy and understanding are essential.

Winter Uniform Reminder

As the weather cools, students can stay warm and in uniform! Cozy layering options include solid black or maroon sweaters, cardigans, or CSPA quarter-zips.
