December Learning Targets

Here's what the Vaquita kids are working on this month:

Science and Social Studies

- Beginning our investigation of animals that hibernate, migrate, and adapt & having a mini hibernation celebration
- Learning about Holiday traditions from around the globe and seeing what they have in common with our own traditions
- Learning about the four seasons and why have seasons

Math:

- Using partners numbers to make and take apart combinations of 5-10 and writing number sentences
- Counting to 100 by 1's, 10's and 5's

Literacy

- Working on strategies to read emergent level 'pattern books'
- Learning how readers:
 - Listen for repeat, rhythm and rhyme in pattern texts
 - Notice how pictures change and think about how the pattern might change within the text

Writing:

 Learning how writers write sentences, use a vowel chart to help them spell and use popcorn words in their writing
