ALL UNITS:

Welcome Back! I hope everyone had a wonderful Winter Break. All units will begin the month of January working on a special project for their families. This special project will be given to their families after their Spring Concerts in June.

KINDERGARTEN:

All Kindergarten students will end the month exploring what we can do with shapes. Students are going to be making shape pizzas! Using tempera paint we are painting our sauce and crust on a thick paper plate. Once dry, students are using different shape ingredients to add toppings to their pizzas.

NAVIGATOR:

Navigator students are learning about Pop Art and artists Roy Lichtenstein and Andy Warhol. Using this art movement for inspiration to create a 'pop'corn collage. Students will get a chance to explore a new way of printmaking, as well as how to layer a collage. This project will also feature some 3D elements.

VOYAGER:

Voyager students are going to be introduced to a new art form of sewing! Students are going to be sewing a Pop Tart Pillow with elements of their personality. We are going to be using felt for details on the pillow. Students will learn how to thread a needle, sew a whip stitch, and how to create a pillow.

EXPLORER:

We are continuing our sewing unit. Students are going to be creating a Slice of Pizza Pillow. We are going to be using felt for details on the pillow. Students will learn how to thread a needle, sew a whip stitch, and how to create a pillow.

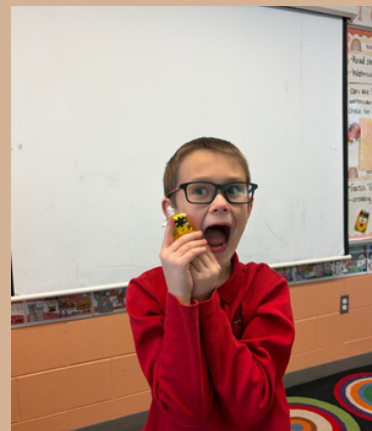
