### Highlights from the Beluga Classroom

-During the month of December we learned about what animals do in winter, Holidays Around the World; Hanukkah, Christmas, Kwanza and Happy Christmas, Linus Minus, writing numbers beyond 30, wrote a personal narrative about their favorite winter memory and completed grinch and holiday themed activities.

### During the month of January we are:

- \*Learning about weather; how do humans adapt to winter weather
- \*The New Year
- \*Learning about Martin Luther King Jr.
- \*Science-states of matter (Melty the Snowman)
- \*Antarctica Geography shelf
- \*Hands on Museum Field Trip
- \*Force and Motion
- \*Review sentence structure; starting with a capital letter and ending with either a period, question mark, or exclamation mark
- \*Learning new sight words
- \*Review all lowercase letters and continue working toward accurate, consistent letter formation.
- \*Use the power of re-reading
- \*Readers stretch through the words, look for familiar chunks, flip the vowel sound (& other animal reading strategies focused on decoding skills) and use numerous strategies at once
- \*Solve tricky parts by continuing to point under each word even if you know the pattern by heart.
- \*Think about what is happening in the book to help them point to and read the words
- \*Students will continue learning about subtraction
- \*Continue solving fact families
- \*Creating snowflake and winter art projects
