## KINDERGARTEN:

All Kindergarten students will end the month exploring what we can do with shapes. Students are going to be making shape pizzas! Using tempera paint we are painting our sauce and crust on a thick paper plate. Once dry, students are using different shape ingredients to add toppings to their pizzas. Students are finishing up the month creating Literature based art for March is Reading Month.

## NAVIGATOR:

Navigator students are learning about Pop Art and artists Roy Litchenstein and Andy Warhol. Using this art movement for inspiration to create a 'pop'corn collage. Students will get a chance to explore a new way of printmaking, as well as how to layer a collage. This project will also feature some 3D elements. Students are finishing up the month creating Literature based art for March is Reading Month.

## VOYAGER:

Voyager students are going to be introduced to a new art form of sewing! Students are going to be sewing a Pop Tart Pillow with elements of their personality. We are going to be using felt for details on the pillow. Students will learn how to thread a needle, sew a whip stitch, and how to create a pillow. Continuing with the food theme, students are going to be led through a guided drawing of a gum ball machine. Students are inspired by the artist Wayne Thiebaud for their designs.

## EXPLORER:

We are continuing our sewing unit. Students are going to be creating a Slice of Pizza Pillow. We are going to be using felt for details on the pillow. Students will learn how to thread a needle, sew a whip stitch, and how to create a pillow. Students are also going to be designing shoes based on a candy bar of their choice.
