Information about Auditions (Voyager & Explorer Only)

In May, Voyager and Explorer students will have the opportunity to audition for a solo/soli part for their concerts. There are many factors that go into choosing the soloists, but the best advice I have for a student is that practice is key! :)



Auditions will take place on Friday, May 8th and Friday, May 15th in the morning in the music room. Students must sign up with me, Mrs. Yamaguchi, if they are interested in auditioning.

If you know ahead of time that your child will not be at school on the day of the audition, please schedule a separate time with me before the audition date to be considered. I will be sure to make time to listen to auditions before or after school if needed.

A parent/guardian may also email their student's audition to my school email over the weekend if their child is unexpectedly sick on the day of. Unfortunately I will not be able to accept any auditions after those dates, as I will be choosing the soloists over the weekend to be posted on Monday morning.

Thank you for your understanding and support as there will only be a few students selected out of the many talented students we have here at CSA. Please remember that each and every student is equally important and unique in a performance like this and we need ALL of their voices to create beautiful music!

After our concerts in June, we will spend some time watching and reflecting on the performances.

Explorer students will be participating in an "Instrument Petting Zoo" on Friday, June 12th. This is when Marshall Music visits CSA so the Explorer students get the opportunity to try out band instruments (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, horn, baritone, and possibly some percussion) to give students an idea of what it may feel like to learn a wind and/or percussion instrument before they get to the middle school.
