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
"ELF and SAFETY"

TV presenter, Kirsty Gallacher, was convicted of drink driving after a night out with friends. Ms Gallacher had taken a taxi home and was returning the following morning to pick up her car. When breathalysed she had three times the legal alcohol limit in her system. The Sky Sports presenter received a two-year driving ban and two years' unpaid community service. People charged with this offence are not necessarily habitual risk takers or drink drivers disregarding the safety of others. But if someone has consumed a significant amount of alcohol the night before then wakes up and gets behind the wheel - even if they feel fine or just tired - then they can easily fall foul of the law as alcohol takes time to leave a person's body depending on their height and weight, the quantity of alcohol and the period of time over which it was consumed.

Generally speaking, if you drink a significant amount of alcohol late into the night and have an early start the following day then YOU are at risk.

See for yourself by going onto morning-after.org.uk. You can calculate when it is safe to drive after having a drink. Obviously it is not absolutely accurate and will not be a defence should you be breathalysed but it certainly gives food for thought. BE SAFE – you are all too important
