Sepsis

Sepsis is a life-threatening condition that arises when the body's response to infection causes injury to its own tissues and organs. Common signs and symptoms include fever, increased heart rate, increased breathing rate, and confusion. There may also be symptoms related to a specific infection, such as a cough with pneumonia, or painful urination with a kidney infection. In the very young, old, and people with a weakened immune system, there may be no symptoms of a specific infection and the body temperature may be low or normal, rather than high. Severe sepsis is sepsis causing poor organ function or insufficient blood flow. Insufficient blood flow may be evident by low blood pressure, high blood lactate, or low urine output. Septic shock is low blood pressure due to sepsis that does not improve after fluid replacement.

Symptoms

In general, symptoms of sepsis can include:

Chills

Confusion or delirium
Fever or low body temperature (hypothermia)
Light-headedness due to low blood pressure
Rapid heartbeat
Shaking
Skin rash
Warm skin

Causes

Any infection can trigger sepsis, but the following types of infections are more likely to cause sepsis:

Pneumonia
Abdominal infection
Kidney infection
Bloodstream infection




Winter Gin Festival 8th February 2020 at The Greenbank Hotel Falmouth

BUSH FIRES ARE DEVASTATING AUSTRALIA. DONATE TO AN APPEAL, OR BECOME A KOALA PROTECTOR.

AUSTRALIA BUSH FIRE EMERGENCY Australia is facing some of the most dangerous and catastrophic bush fires they have ever seen.

The fires in Australia are devastating – and the crisis is still ongoing. More than 10 million hectares have been burnt, and this number continues to climb. That's the equivalent of 40% of the entire UK. Lives, homes, and an estimated 1.25 billion animals have been affected, including 30% of the entire koala population in mid-north coast of New South Wales. These catastrophic mega fires are worsening the extinction crisis we're already facing.

With the money raised, our Australia teams along with local organisations will carry out work including: Providing emergency funds to care for injured wildlife. After the fires clear, helping restore homes for koalas and other wildlife, planting the first 10,000 trees urgently needed in koala habitats Supporting the response, recovery and restoration teams in any other way we can Helping pressure governments to strengthen laws that prevent excessive tree-clearing, before it's too late Alternatively, you can become a Koala Protector from £25 and receive your personalisable certificate.
