POLICY & PROCEDURAL STATEMENT

REPORTING TO PARENTS

RATIONALE

Reciprocal partnerships between whānau and kura are vital for tamariki success.

PURPOSE

1. To kōrero with parents/whānau tamariki progress
2. To increase whānau understanding of programmes and achievement levels
3. To encourage and foster whānau their children's progress
4. To provide whānau with assurance of professional competence of kaiako
5. To establish common goals with whānau in respect to their children

GUIDELINES

1. Reporting will cover areas of social, emotional, physical and academic development
2. Reporting will be continuous, parents will be given the opportunity to meet at regular intervals. Whānau kōrero and written reports will occur twice a year.
3. Face to face kōrero will usually be more effective than written communication and will promote a feeling of mutual responsibility for the progress and development of tamariki
4. Individual Pupil Profiles are kept for each tamariki and are on-going
5. Informal reporting to parents may occur from time to time
