Methodology

Interview Dates June 14th – June 15th, 2025

Target Population National registered voters

Sampling Method The survey employed a dual-mode random sample of

the national voter file. A stratified random draw of

mobile phone numbers was split into:

70 % SMS text-to-web invitations, directing respondents to a secure online questionnaire.

30 % live interviewer calls to mobile phones.

Sampling strata were defined by region, party, gender, age, 2024 vote, and education to ensure

geographic and demographic coverage.

Weighting The sample was weighted based on gender, age,

college education, party self ID, race, 2024 Presidential

vote, region, and election participation.

Weighting targets were derived from a national voter file appended with consumer data and informed by analysis of the 2024 presidential election to accurately

reflect the demographics of registered voters.
