Role Description

The Game Changers Leader is responsible for guiding and facilitating the Game Changers youth ministry program within the school. This role involves nurturing students' spiritual growth, leadership skills, and commitment to service, aligning with the Marist charism and the teachings of Saint Marcellin Champagnat. The Game Changers Leader collaborates with the Marist Youth Ministry team to implement the program's three tracks: Le Rosey, La Valla, and Hermitage, ensuring a cohesive and enriching experience for students from Years 7 to 12. The Social Justice Leader is expected to uphold all legislative obligations related to Child Safeguarding and Occupational Health and Safety, in alignment with College policies. This role may receive an increase in time release during peak periods.

Key Areas of Responsibilities

The Game Changers Leader is responsible for:

- Actively promotes and embodies the vision and mission of Assumption College as a Catholic and Marist school, grounding all leadership in faith and service.
- Models and communicates appropriate processes and procedures, fostering consistency and professionalism across all aspects of the Game Changers program.
- Contributes to the development, review, and implementation of relevant College policies and procedures, particularly those related to student formation and Catholic identity.

Key Duties

- Coordinate and facilitate the Game Changers program across all year levels, ensuring alignment with Marist Youth Ministry frameworks.
- Induct, train, and support staff leaders involved in the program, providing guidance, resources, and regular opportunities for collaboration and reflection.
- Organise and oversee key Game Changers events such as retreats, service initiatives, and liturgical celebrations that contribute to the spiritual and leadership development of students.
- Maintain effective communication with students, staff, families, and the Marist Youth Ministry team to ensure the program is well-integrated and impactful.

- Monitor student engagement and participation, identifying opportunities to enhance the program's reach and strengthen its connection to the life of the College.
- Any other duties as outlined by the Principal.
