We're excited to have your camper join us at KASPER Camp at the Community Recreation Center in Community (upstairs)! With enrichment, outdoor recreation, swimming, and a focus on well-being, we're creating a safe, positive, and fun environment for all. **ALL ARE WELCOME AT KASPER!**

The CRC Community Team is made up of dedicated, well-trained, and friendly KASPER staff, all eager to create unique and exciting experiences for your campers. Through a balance of small and large group activities, freedom of choice, creativity, and a strong sense of respect and belonging, we aim to provide every child with the ultimate summer adventure. To help camp run smoothly, please review the key details below.

### Weekly Camp Expectations:

- Please familiarize yourself with the **KASPER Family Handbook** which is intended to provide you with an overview of the guidelines, policies and procedures that have been put in place for the safety of all who attend SPD Camps.
- **Lunch/Snacks:** Campers must bring a nutritious, protein-filled lunch and extra snacks daily. No snacks will be provided.
- **Sunscreen:** To ensure proper sun protection, staff will schedule regular group breaks for sunscreen reapplication throughout the day—even on cloudy days. Campers **must** bring a sufficient supply of sunscreen each day. If a camper does not have sunscreen, they will be limited to indoor or shaded activities (if available) for their safety—**no exceptions**.
- **Swimming:** All campers will be given a swim test administered by SPD lifeguards. Campers who do not take or do not pass the test will be limited to a designated shallow area for safety. If you prefer that your child not swim or skip the swim test, please notify the Site Coordinator. Campers are allowed to wear coast guard-approved life jackets and puddle jumpers.

### Drop Off & Pick Up (7:00 AM – 6:00 PM):

- Drop-off starts at 7:00 AM (doors will not open earlier).
- Arrive before 9:00 AM daily.
- Campers must be **signed in & out daily** by authorized individuals (listed in ePACT).
- **No pick-up/drop-off allowed at off-site locations** (field trips or pools).
