**Review of new business**

1. Replacement of 3 bay doors at the Vinemont-Providence Fire Department-Total cost of materials-\$7380.00(The Towns obligation per our contract is to pay for material and the fire department would pay for labor) Attached is the quote for replacement. I would suggest using Capital Improvement Fund-No questions or concerns.
2. Street Paving/stripping
  - Stripping-Federer, Roberson, Johnson, Nesmith, Kelley, Virginia, Lipsey, Oakley, CR 1297-\$4,527.00
  - Paving-Oakley-\$23,112.00
  - Paving-Lipsey-\$11,114.00
  - Paving/stripping-Overlay-CR 1296 only in front of new homes within our municipal limits-\$19,125.00
  - Repair Park Drive-\$4,690.00.
  - Paving-Adding Additional parking behind Storm shelter at Community Center 15 spots-\$24,400.00
  - Total Cost \$86,968.00 Using 4,5,7 Cent funds-\$36,992.73 Already Allocated RRA Funds-\$20293.78 Remaining amount would be \$29,681.49 (All of these projects do not have to be approved all at once, the main items would be Lipsey, Oakley, striping and repair of Park Drive)Mrs. Arnett asked why Wood Street was not being striped, Mr. Graves made her aware that the width of the road would need to be 16ft wide for the company to strip it.

Mr. Graves informed council the size would be 40x8, which would increase the size, this would include turf and the roof, this would be great if we want to close it in the future. No questions or concerns.


