1. Mayor Goodwin introduced Resolution No. 2026-08-01 Authorization for mayor to sign agreement with Municipal Workers Compensation Fund. No questions or concerns.
2. Mayor Goodwin introduced Resolution No. 2026-08-02 CD-\$10,000.00 Future Employee Retirement Contribution to RSA. No questions or concerns.

5. Mayor Goodwin introduced the Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan 2026-2027. Michael Ashbaugh asked what this plan intel. Clerk made him aware that new gas tax that was passed several years ago was allocated to municipalities for this to be used for road improvements. These funds have a separate account that it goes in since the law prohibits these funds to be comingled with anything else. No further questions or concerns.
6. Mayor Goodwin introduced the product CSA-Software Solutions-New Business/Privilege License Module \$2,295.00. No questions or concerns.
7. Mayor Goodwin opened discussion -Christmas lighting on Hwy 31. Kelley Little asked where the lights would be located. Clerk made the council aware that it would be on the north and south bound side where there are no streetlights on poles, it would be a total of 13 poles. Clerk did make them aware that the Cullman Electric Co-Op [engineer will need to come and do a site review as of right now they are 3-6 weeks out, so it may be next season before everything is ready if they choice to put lights up.



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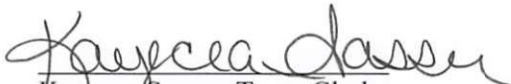

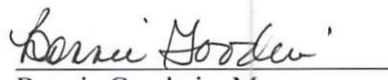
