#### Today's CoP Demographics (pulled 11/12/25)

- States represented (N=18): Alaska, California, Colorado, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Maine, Maryland, Michigan, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Virginia
- 24 (50%) registered participants attended the 2025 District Leadership Institute in Chicago
- 3 (6%) registered participants are current/former SCTG awardees
- 14 (29%) registered participants attended the 24-25 District Leadership CoP Series
- 144 Participants across the district size alikes:

Small (4500 or less) = 14 (29%) Medium (4501 - 25,000) = 16 (34\%)

Large (25,001 - 90,000) = 15 (31%) Very Large (90,001 or more) = 3 (6%)
