Your personalized schedule, listing the sessions you registered for, can be found in the **My Schedule** section.

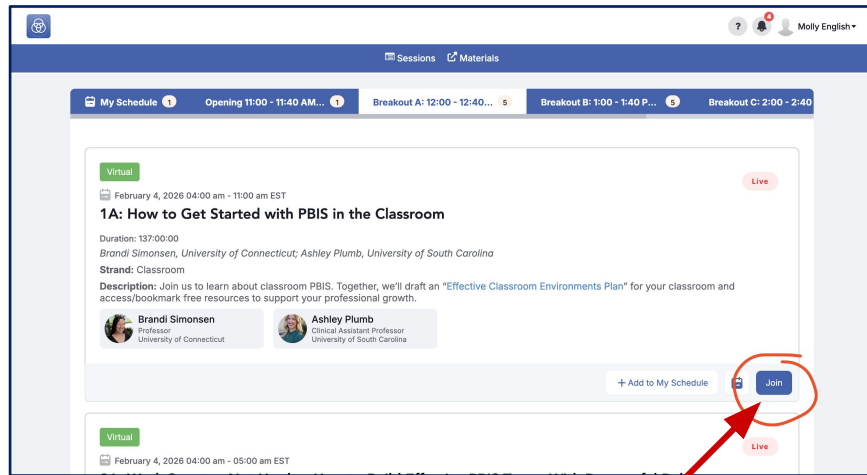


Switching Sessions

1. Exit your current zoom session...Click Exit

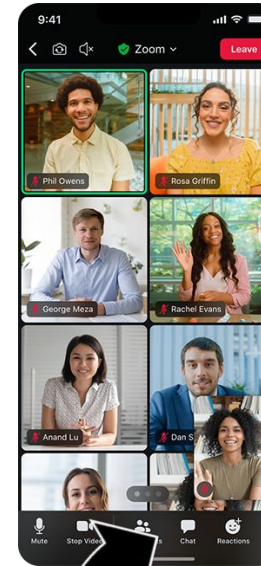


2. Navigate back to the Live Sessions Page



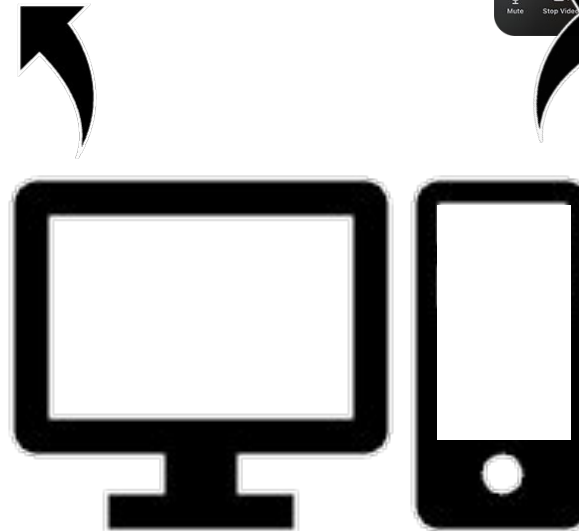
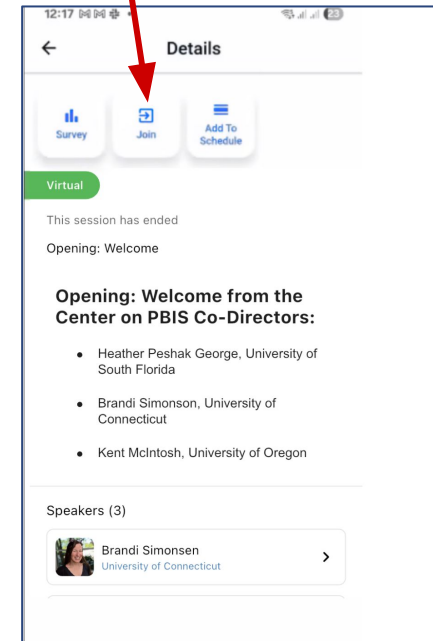
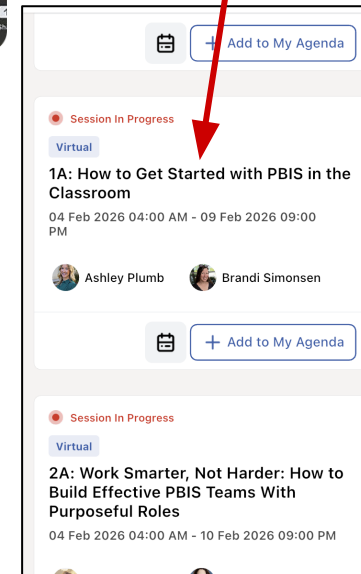




