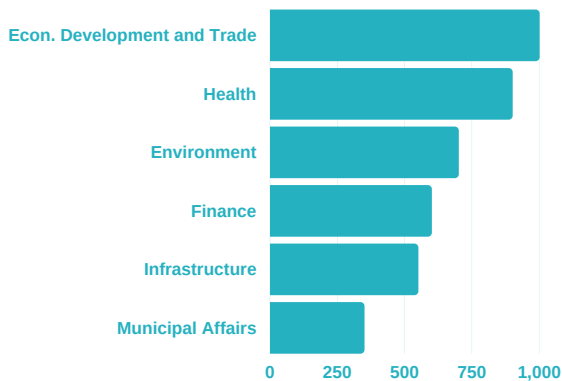
About PAAC

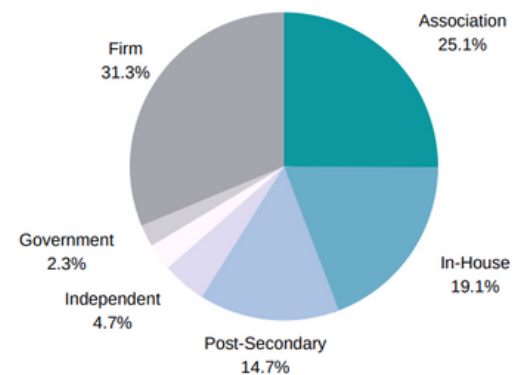
What PAAC Delivers
