The school does not tolerate conduct that violates biblical principles, dishonors God, or casts a poor reflection on the name and reputation of the school.
9.	We/I understand that when a student is withdrawn or expelled, the current month's charges are due and payable. We also understand that assessments will be made if our child is responsible for damage to any school property.
